BACKGROUND:

Summary

The proposed County/Flood Payroll Warrant/Direct Deposit General Support Services Fee rate increase of 52 cents (9.67%), to \$5.90 from the previous FY 2023/24 rate of \$5.38.

Predominantly, this year's increase of 9.67% is attributable to the proposed MOU Salary and Benefit increases (6.89%) expected to be realized in the upcoming budget year. To a much lesser degree, the expansion of duties and the accompanying resources (1 FTE's - Acct. Tech II) needed to administer and oversee certain aspects of on-going MOU language changes and the necessity to remain in compliance with Federal and State regulatory rules and regulations such as Code of Federal Regulations (29 CFR - Labor) and monitoring IRS rule changes and interpretations. This position will account for the remaining 2.78%.

The proposed rate was prepared in accordance with Board Policy B-4 and Board Policy B-28. A detailed analysis supporting the calculation is available at the Office of the Auditor-Controller.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

Approval of the rate will allow the Auditor-Controller's Payroll Division to continue to assist its customers with the payroll function. This support will contribute to the overall efficiency of departmental operations and will allow each department to better serve Riverside County residents.
