1. Ratify and approve the Universal Terms Order Form Software 2023-013997 7183286/ DPSS-0005039 Agreement with SAS Institute Inc. for SAS Data Reporting Software without seeking competitive bids for a total amount of \$83,649 for one year, effective December 30, 2023, through December 31, 2024, and authorize the Chairman of the Board to sign the Agreement on behalf of the County; and,
2. Authorize the Purchasing Agent, or designee, based on the availability of fiscal funding and as approved as to form by County Counsel to: (a) sign amendments that make modifications to the scope of services that stay within the intent of the Agreement; and (b) sign amendments to the compensation provisions that do not exceed the sum total of twenty percent (20%) of the total cost of the agreement.

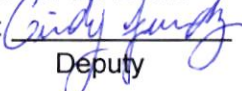

BACKGROUND:

Summary

Welfare and Institutions Code sections 10850, 14100.2 14005.35, 14005.36, and 14005.37 allows Riverside County Department of Public Social Services (DPSS) to share data with multiple agencies for the purpose of program administration. The SAS data extraction mechanism allows DPSS to provide customizable data reporting to multiple partner agencies. SAS reporting software allows for state data extraction, data processing, data matching, data validation, and data reporting.

SAS Institute Inc. is a technology firm and the proprietor and developer of SAS Analytics, which is the leading data analysis software in the market.

This board action will approve the Universal Terms Order Form Software 2023-013997 7183286/ DPSS-0005039 with SAS Institute Inc. for their Data Reporting Software SAS without seeking competitive bids for a one-year term effective December 30, 2023, through December 31, 2024 as a result of Sole Source Justification # 24-145.

DPSS processes more than 150 reports weekly that track program performance and inform decision-making. These reports are distributed to numerous partner agencies, executive teams, and multiple county executives that oversee programs. SAS software does an outstanding job in managing data integrity and overall satisfaction. Moreover, DPSS provides the Riverside County Board of Supervisors with reporting on community indicators and demographical information that are directly generated by SAS.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

SAS Analytics allows DPSS to generate business intelligence reports and share data with partner agencies for multiple efforts, including Medi-Cal Managed Care Providers Data Sharing, School Lunch Program Direct Certification Data Sharing, Child Welfare program outcomes measurement, Welfare-to-Work Data Sharing with community colleges, among other efforts. These reporting tools support multiple programs and projects that help DPSS service over one million Riverside County residents annually.

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SUPPLEMENTAL:

Additional Fiscal Information

SAS's scope of work includes consulting fees (technical assistance) and an annual subscription for unlimited licensing. SAS technical assistance fees will be to substitute RCIT's assistance in the event that RCIT can no longer provide assistance to this effort. The budget breakdown is as follows:

Contract History and Price Reasonableness

DPSS has maintained a long relationship with SAS and gets a lower discount than attaining a new quote at market. Renewal rates are the same year after year or slightly increased based on market inflation, among other factors. The renewal is about half of what it would cost to buy this software new.

Unless the Pricing Metric is based on the processing capacity of the Authorized Environment, the Pricing Metric quantity is determined by combining the quantity associated with Customer and its Related Entities benefitting from the use of the Offering. If Customer expands the use of the Offering to benefit additional Related Entities, Customer will notify SAS of any increase to the Pricing Metric quantity and pay any applicable additional Fees. - The applicable governing law in Section 16.1 of the Universal Terms shall be the laws of the State of California
- Section 16.2 of the Universal Terms shall not apply to this Order Form.
- Section 12 of the Universal Terms shall only apply to the extent permitted by applicable law.

The Universal Terms is amended to include the following. This Agreement shall be effective January 1, 2024 and continue through December 31, 2024. SAS shall commence performance upon the effective date and shall diligently and continuously perform thereafter.

- A. After receipt of the notice of termination, SAS shall:
- (1) Stop all work under this Agreement on the date specified in the notice of termination; and
 - (2) Transfer to CUSTOMER and deliver in the manner directed by CUSTOMER any materials, reports or other products, which, if the Agreement had been completed or continued, would be required to be furnished to CUSTOMER.
- B. After termination, CUSTOMER shall make payment only for SAS's performance up to the date of termination in accordance with this Agreement.
- C. The rights and remedies of CUSTOMER provided in this section shall not be exclusive and are in addition to any other rights or remedies provided by law or this Agreement.

Section 15 of the Universal Terms is amended to include:

CYBER LIABILITY

SAS shall procure and maintain for the duration of the contract insurance against claims for injuries to person or damages to property which may arise from or in connection with the performance of the work hereunder by SAS, its agents, representatives, or employees. SAS shall procure and maintain for the duration of the contract insurance claims arising out of their services and including, but not limited to loss, damage, theft or other misuse of data, infringement of intellectual property, invasion of privacy and breach of data.

SAS shall procure and maintain cyber liability Insurance, with limits not less than \$2,000,000 per occurrence or claim, \$2,000,000 aggregate. Coverage shall be sufficiently broad to respond to the duties and obligations as is undertaken by SAS in this Agreement and shall include damages suffered by others resulting from a failure of computer security, including liability caused by theft or disclosure of confidential information, unauthorized access, unauthorized use, denial of service attack or transmission of a computer virus. The policy shall provide coverage for breach response costs as well as regulatory fines and penalties as well as credit monitoring expenses with limits sufficient to respond to these obligations.

Section 16.1 is amended to include: Any legal action related to the interpretation or performance of this Agreement shall be filed only in the Superior Court for the State of California or the U.S. District Court located in Riverside, California. Except for claim of intellectual property infringement, prior to the filing

of any legal action related to this Agreement, the parties shall be obligated to attend a mediation session in Riverside Customer before a neutral third party mediator. The parties shall share the cost of the mediation.

Section 17.5 is amended as follows: Failure to require compliance with a part of the Agreement is not a waiver of that part. Nothing in the Agreement waives any remedy that either party may have under the Agreement at law, in equity, or otherwise.


The Universal Terms is amended to include the following:

The obligation of CUSTOMER for payment under this Agreement beyond the current County fiscal year is contingent upon and limited by the availability of County funding from which payment can be made. There shall be no legal liability for payment on the part of CUSTOMER beyond June 30 of each year unless funds are made available for such payment by the Board of Supervisors. In the event such funds are not forthcoming for any reason, CUSTOMER shall immediately notify SAS in writing and this Agreement shall be deemed terminated and be of no further force or effect. CUSTOMER shall make all payments to SAS that were properly earned prior to the unavailability of funding.

This Agreement may be executed in any number of counterparts, each of which when executed shall constitute a duplicate original, but all counterparts together shall constitute a single agreement.

Each party of this Agreement agrees to the use of electronic signatures, such as digital signatures that meet the requirements of the California Uniform Electronic Transactions Act ("CUETA") Cal. Civ. Code §§ 1633.1 to 1633.17), for executing this Agreement. The parties further agree that the electronic signature(s) included herein are intended to authenticate this writing and to have the same force and effect as manual signatures. Electronic signature means an electronic sound, symbol, or process attached to or logically associated with an electronic record and executed or adopted by a person with the intent to sign the electronic record pursuant to the CUETA as amended from time to time. Digital signature means an electronic identifier, created by computer, intended by the party using it to have the same force and effect as the use of a manual signature, and shall be reasonably relied upon by the parties. For purposes of this section, a digital signature is a type of "electronic signature" as defined in subdivision (i) of Section 1633.2 of the Civil Code.

The individual signing or accepting this Order Form must have the authority to bind Customer to the Agreement.

This request is for a one-year agreement for business intelligence software licenses and SAS Consulting Services. DPSS will be transitioning to Viya, an AI based platform by SAS, subsequent SSJ will be provided for this service.

6. Unique features of the supply/service being requested from this supplier. SAS Software and its programming language are proprietary to SAS Institute Inc. SAS Software is only offered within the SAS platform (please see the attached attestation letter from SAS). DPSS is able to connect to and extract data directly from the CalSAWS eligibility system servers at the state level. SAS Institute is regularly ranked by analyst firms Gartner and Forrester as a leader in advanced analytics and business intelligence applications.

The software allows for data queries that enable extraction for multiple reporting, including business partner reports, executive reports, and Board of Supervisors reports.

DPSS has identified SAS as a leader in the business intelligence platform market, particularly for advanced analytical tools, such as data mining, forecasting, and predictive modeling. DPSS has also identified that SAS is the solution for our DPSS's CalSAWS welfare data because its ability to handle large and complex data.

DPSS uses SAS to do perform complex statistical data analysis and reporting for the State, Board of Supervisors and other programmatic stakeholders..

7. Reasons why my department requires these unique features from the vendor and what benefit will accrue to the county:

DPSS processes more than 150 reports weekly that track program performance and inform decision-making. These reports are distributed to numerous partner agencies, executive teams, and multiple county executives that oversee programs. SAS software does an outstanding job in managing data integrity and overall satisfaction. Moreover, DPSS provides the Riverside County Board of Supervisors with reporting on community indicators and demographical information that are directly generated by SAS.

By continuing with SAS, DPSS can continue providing uninterrupted reporting. Based on RCITs recommendation, DPSS will work with SAS to attain their Viya web-based platform in preparation for fiscal year 2024-25 to keep up with new demands on online data sharing. Viya is a proprietary online web-based platform owned by SAS that performs the same capacities as their 9.4 version.
