Authorize the Clerk of the Board to advertise for bids to be received by the office of the Director of Transportation and Land Management at the Transportation Annex located at 3525 14th Street, Riverside, CA 92501. All bids must be received up to the hour of 2:00 p.m., Wednesday, January 31, 2024 at which time bids will be opened.



**BACKGROUND:**

**Summary**

Avenue 48 is an east-west major arterial roadway in the City of Coachella and the County of Riverside (County). Avenue 48, between Van Buren Street and Dillon Road, currently consists of two vehicular lanes (one lane in each direction) and a striped two-way left turn median. The northerly half of Avenue 48 is in the jurisdictional boundary of the County and the southerly half is in the jurisdictional boundary of the City of Coachella.

The Coachella Valley Association of Governments (CVAG), the City of Coachella, and the County desire to widen Avenue 48 between Van Buren Street and Dillon Road (Project) to alleviate congestion and help improve traffic circulation. The proposed improvements will add one westbound lane and one eastbound lane with a raised concrete median. In addition, curb, gutter, and sidewalk will be constructed in the westbound direction and a five-foot wide bike lane will be provided in the eastbound direction.

Additional improvements include construction of Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) compliant curb ramps, cross gutter and spandrels, residential driveways, construction of pavement safety edge to protect the outside edge of pavement, reconstruction of private property improvements (fences, planters, concrete curbs, asphalt and concrete driveway connections, etc.), installation of traffic striping, thermoplastic crosswalks and pavement markings, installation of traffic signs, and other associated work.

The work also includes modifications to the existing traffic signals at Van Buren Street and Dillon Road for the existing video detection system due to the additional traffic lanes and bike lane.

The submitted plans and specifications have been approved as to form by County Counsel.

The bid documents include the following bid schedules of work:

Alternative Bid Schedule 1: Valley Sanitary District (VSD) Facility Adjustments

Improvements within the City of Indio are included within Base Bid Schedule A. City of Indio will cover its share of the costs, as stated in the Service Agreement approved by the Board of Supervisors on September 26, 2023 (Agenda Item 3.31).

The adjustment of the facilities owned by VSD are also included in the bid package as Alternative Bid Schedule 1. If VSD approves the award of their alternative bid schedule, as bid by the apparent low bidder, the cost for the work will be funded by VSD through a reimbursement letter Agreement that will be executed by the Director of Transportation. The Director of Transportation has the authority to sign reimbursement Agreements up to \$100,000 per Minute Order dated November 19, 2019 (Agenda Item 3.25).

The Transportation Department will select the contractor based upon the lowest responsive and responsible bid.

**Environmental Findings**

The County Board of Supervisors at its meeting on March 10, 2020 (Item 3.45), adopted the Final Initial Study with Mitigated Negative Declaration and Monitoring Programs for the Avenue 48 Widening Project based on the conclusion that the project will not have a significant effect on the environment. The approval of the plans and specifications and authorization to advertise for bids is an implementing action in furtherance of the project, and no further documentation is required under CEQA.

**Impact on Citizens and Businesses**

The proposed improvements will provide safety, alleviate congestion, and operational efficiency for pedestrians and local traffic on Avenue 48. Widening the roadway will improve pedestrian and vehicular traffic circulation and access for motorists, residents, businesses, emergency service providers, nearby institutions such as schools, and public transportation. The project is consistent with the County's, City of Coachella's, and City of Indio's General Plans to meet current and future traffic demands.

The work is scheduled to begin in May/June 2024. The work will be phased to keep the road open during construction as much as possible and will take approximately two and a half months to complete.

**SUPPLEMENTAL:**

**Additional Fiscal Information**

The construction contract is estimated to cost approximately \$2,580,980. Per Agency Reimbursement Agreement and Amendments (by Minute Orders: June 20, 2017 – Agenda Item 3.41; April 27, 2021 – Agenda Item 3.32, June 13, 2023 – Agenda Item 3.30), CVAG agreed to

pay 75% of all qualified Project costs (including design, environmental, right-of-way, and construction) not to exceed \$4,700,000.

County will invoice CVAG for 100% of the eligible project costs. CVAG will in turn invoice the County and the City of Coachella for proportional shares of the 25% Local Share for this Project.

The County's proportional share for the Project will be funded with Gas Tax/HUTA Funds. The Cities of Coachella and Indio are responsible for funding their proportional share for the Project.

Valley Sanitary District is responsible for funding their respective alternate bid schedule in full if submitted bid prices, submitted by the apparent low bidder, are approved and included in the construction Contract.

There are no General Funds used in this project.

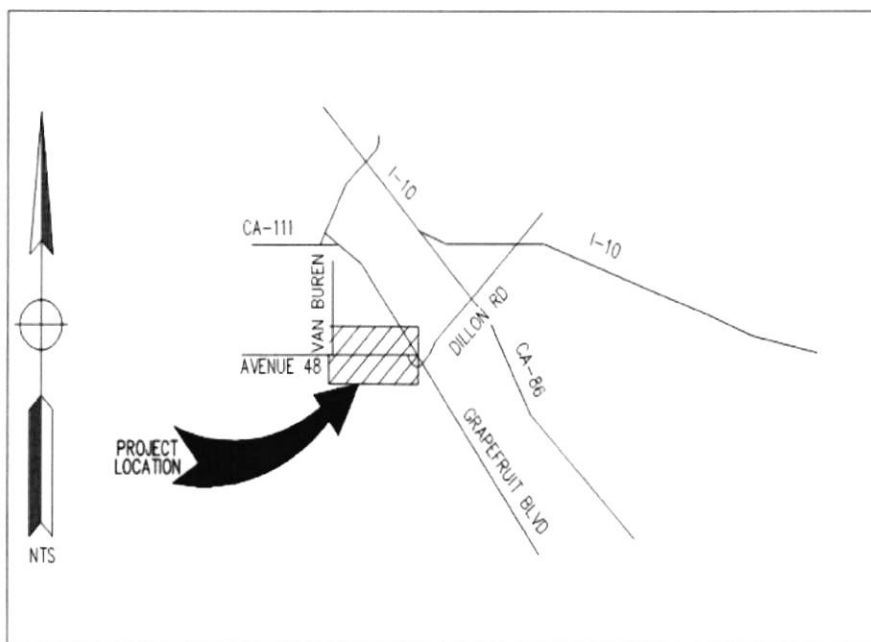
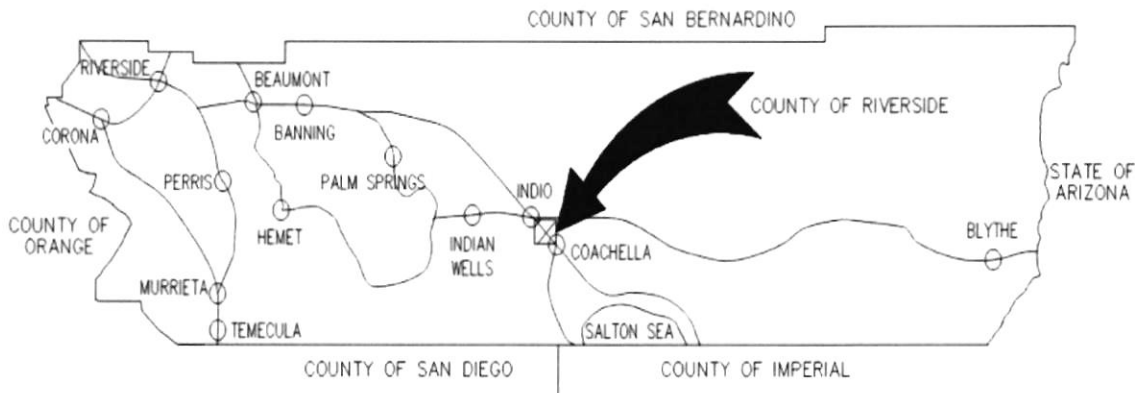


