

BACKGROUND: Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

1. The Joslyn Center provides health, recreational, educational, and social programs along with information, referral volunteer and support services. CID funds will assist with staged readings and small theater production for Seniors on Stage.
2. The Palm Springs Air Museum will host their Heroes of Modern Teach Annual Gala on February 10, 2024. This event raises funds for their Commemorative Educational Programs which supports educational, cultural, and historical significance programs which takes place inside the Miles Hanger.
3. Desert Ensemble Theatre Company's high school technical theatre internships give students on-the-job experience working in professional productions, mentored by professional theatre practitioners. Three to five students participate every year, from Cathedral City High School and Palm Springs High School. CID funds will be used to help with the costs of the program.
4. Coachella Valley Wrestling at Coachella Valley High School is a year-round sport. Through the sport of wrestling students are taught grit, perseverance, focus, sacrifice, and attitude. CID funds will be used to assist with the purchase of gear for students.
5. Read with me Volunteers mission is to assist local children from a low income, limited English speaking environment to develop their fullest potential by helping them learn to read, comprehend, and speak English, while understanding that people care about them as individuals. CID funds will be used for recruitment, registration, and training volunteers.
6. GirlFriend Factor supports and empowers local underserved women over the age of 25, by providing renewable grants to fund educational and/or vocational training. The 40 in 4 Initiative supports 40 women who will graduate within 4 years with degrees in healthcare professions with a focus on RNs and BSNs. CID funds will be used towards the 40 in 4 Initiative.
7. Riverside County DPSS will host the Riverside County Elder and Dependent Adult Abuse Symposium on June 13, 2024, at the Riverside Convention Center. This event works to engage the community in the protection and empowerment of elder and dependent adults throughout Riverside County. CID funds will be used to help cover the cost of this event.
8. College of the Desert Public Safety Academy provides education and training in the local public safety sector. CID funds will help with grants for 10 students to participate in the Module I course.
9. The Palm Springs Health Run & Wellness Festival will be held on Saturday, January 27, 2024 at Ruth Hardy Park in Palm Springs. The event will provide a health and fitness-oriented routine. In addition, more than 100 health and wellness booths will provide resources and services, rock climbing wall, walk on water and more. CID funds will help cover expenses of the event.
