Ordinance No 982 provides that the Board of Supervisors, as the legislative body of the District, is authorized and directed each fiscal year to determine or cause to be determined the specific special tax rate and amount to be levied for the next ensuing fiscal year for each parcel of real property within the District. The special tax revenues shall be used to fund, pay for, and finance the Services and shall be levied so long as special taxes are needed to fund such Services. In addition, the special tax revenue may be used to replenish a reserve fund for the District, to pay the costs of administering the District, and fund the cost of collecting and administering the special tax. Ordinance No. 982 provides that the special taxes may be collected on the secured property tax roll in the same manner as ordinary ad valorem taxes and that the special taxes shall have the same procedure and sale in cases of delinquency as provided for ad valorem taxes. The rate and method of apportionment of the special tax authorized by Ordinance No. 982 is the rate and method approved by voters within the District and as further reflected in Exhibit A "Rate and Method" is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors and is available for public inspection and copying in that office in accordance with Section 6250) of Division 7 of Title 1 of the Government Code.
