

BACKGROUND: Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

1. Riverside County Department of Public Social Services, Adult Services Division will use funding to help support their Elder and Dependent Adult Abuse Symposium. The goal is to increase awareness of elder and dependent adult abuse, highlighting innovative programs and strategies aimed at preventing and safeguarding these vulnerable individuals.
2. Moreno Valley Chamber of Commerce will use funding to promote and advocate for businesses, educate their members, interact with local government, and enhance the business support in the community by advocating for policy initiatives. In addition, the Chamber will assist with community events and operations.
3. San Geronio Pass Rotary will use funding for the Polar Express Movie Night that will be hosted for residents of Cabazon and surrounding cities. Funds will pay for the movie, popcorn and activities for children and prizes.
4. Riverside County Fire Department (CAL Fire UNIT) to purchase the necessary food for a 2/28 career fair that will be held at the Ben Clark Training Facility to support our youth with career awareness and opportunities.
