**BACKGROUND:** Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

- Moreno Valley PONY Baseball and Softball (Pinto Mariners) will use funding support to
  players and their families in making it affordable to those that may not have the
  resources to play organized sports. Funding will support with the purchase of equipment
  and fees for field and light usage.
- 2. The Nuevo Citizens Patrol will utilize funds for various purposes to include the enhancement of their CERT trailer by stocking it with water and other emergency supplies, replacing uniforms, covering the maintenance expenses for their security and radio system and upkeeping of the building (including pest and weed control).
- 3. Cherry Festival Association will use funding to host their 104<sup>th</sup> Annual Extravaganza that has been hosted in the city of Beaumont and the Unincorporated Area of Cherry Valley. Funds will be used to provide entertainment and upgrades for safety equipment to be ADA compliant in order to host this event for the residents of Beaumont and surrounding cities.
- 4. Moreno Valley Education Foundation is the "foundation" arm of the Moreno Valley Unified School District and will use the funds to provide various grants for at-risk students, families, scholarships, and fund a portion of the Canyon Springs Marching Band 2024-2025 program.
