## BACKGROUND:

The applicant for Plot Plan 180028 is requesting the vacation of two drainage easements, in the Mead Valley area. Plot Plan 180028 has reconfigured the drainage system in this area rendering these drainage easements obsolete. The drainage easements were dedicated, not accepted, for public use by Parcel Map Number 24110 recorded in Book 165, Pages 11 through 18, inclusive of Parcel Maps, records of the Recorder of Riverside County, California. The applicant owns all property affected by this vacation. The Transportation Department and the Riverside County Flood Control and Water Conservation District have reviewed this vacation and have no objections.

As determined in the attached Notice of Exemption, the vacation is exempt from the provisions of CEQA pursuant to15061(b)(3) of the State CEQA Guidelines and/or determined to not be a project under Section 15060(c)(2). The vacation will not cause any direct or indirect physical environmental impacts.

County Counsel has approved Resolution Number 2024-021 as to form.

### Impact on Residents and Businesses

Vacating the right to accept these drainage easements will not impact residents or businesses.

### Additional Fiscal Information

All fees are paid by the applicant. There is no General Fund obligation.



## NOTICE OF EXEMPTION

**Project Name:** Resolution No. 2024-021 Summarily Vacating the right to accept drainage easements in the Mead Valley area.

Project Number: ABS23003, SU14

Project Location-See Exhibits "A" and "B"

**Description of Project:** Resolution No. 2024-021 Summarily Vacating the right to accept drainage easements in the Mead Valley area.

**Name of Public Agency Approving Project:** Riverside County Transportation Department, Survey Division, County of Riverside.

**Name of Person or Agency Carrying Out Project:** David L. McMillan, Riverside County Transportation Department, Survey Division, County of Riverside.

Exempt Status: California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines, Section 15061(b)(3), General Rule "Common Sense" Exemption. Not a "project" as defined under State CEQA Guidelines, Section 15060(c).

**Reasons Why Project is Exempt:** The vacation of a drainage easement has been determined to not be a "project" as defined under State CEQA Guidelines section 15060(c). However, even if it was determined to be a project under CEQA for analysis purposes, the project is exempt from the provisions of CEQA specifically by the State CEQA Guidelines as identified below. The vacation of the drainage easement will not result in any specific or general exceptions to the use of the categorical exemption as detailed under State CEQA Guidelines Section 15300.2. The project will not cause any impacts to scenic resources, historic resources, or unique sensitive environments. Further, no unusual circumstances or potential cumulative impacts would occur that may reasonably create an environmental impact. The vacation of this drainage easement will not have an effect on the environment; thus, the County has deemed this does not meet the definition of a "project" under CEQA and no environmental impacts are anticipated to occur.

Section 15061(b)(3) - General Rule "Common Sense" Exemption. With certainty, there is
no possibility that the proposed project may have a significant effect on the
environment. Vacating a drainage easement will not require any construction activities,
change the use or intensity of the existing site to create a physical environmental impact,
and would not lead to any direct or reasonably foreseeable indirect physical
environmental impacts. Therefore, in no way would vacating a drainage easement have
the potential to cause a significant environmental impact and the vacation is exempt
from further CEQA analysis.

Section 15060(c) – for purposes of analysis under CEQA, Vacating a drainage easement
is not a "project" under CEQA pursuant to Section 15060(c). An action by a public
agency is only a "project" subject to CEQA if the action might result in a physical change
in the environment. Based upon a review of the whole action undertaken, supported, or
authorized by the County, in no way will Vacating a drainage easement increase the use
of the site, result in increased development or construction impacts, or lead to any direct,
indirect, or cumulative physical environmental impacts.

Based upon the identified exemptions above, the County of Riverside hereby concludes that no physical environmental impacts are anticipated to occur and the project as proposed is exempt under CEQA. No further environmental analysis is warranted.


