RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:

- Find that the Dillon Road Resurfacing and Bubbling Wells Road Resurfacing Project is categorically exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines Section 15301 (c) - Existing Facilities;
- Approve the plans and specifications for the construction of the Dillon Road Resurfacing and Bubbling Wells Road Resurfacing Project, in the Community of Southeast Desert Hot Springs;
- Authorize the Clerk of the Board to advertise for bids to be received by the office of the Director of Transportation and Land Management at the Transportation Annex located at 3525 14th Street, Riverside, CA 92501. All bids must be received up to the hour of 2:00 p.m., Wednesday, March 27, 2024 at which time bids will be opened; and
- Direct the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors to file the Notice of Exemption with the County Clerk and the State Clearinghouse, Office of Planning and Research, for posting within five (5) working days.

BACKGROUND:

Summary

The County of Riverside Transportation Department is proposing to resurface approximately 1.5-miles of Dillon Road and 1.5-miles of Bubbling Wells Road in the Community of Southeast Desert Hot Springs in the Coachella Valley area of Riverside County. Dillon Road will be resurfaced from Palm Drive to Mountain View Road and Bubbling Wells Road will be resurfaced from 20th Avenue to Dillon Road.

These two resurfacing projects are combined to bid as one project due to their close proximity and similarities in scope. It is expected that the County will gain cost efficiencies by eliminating multiple bidding and administrative procedures and obtain more favorable proposed costs associated with larger bid quantities.

Dillon Road is a two-lane facility that travels in the East-West direction with a road width of 40 feet to 84 feet. Bubbling Wells Road is a two-lane facility that travels in the North-South direction with a road width of 24 feet.

Roadway resurfacing is needed due to the deteriorated pavement condition. The Dillon Road Resurfacing Project will consist of grinding down a portion of the existing asphalt concrete pavement followed by overlaying back with Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA) pavement. The Bubbling Wells Road Resurfacing Project will consist of grinding existing asphalt concrete in place (pulverize), mixing and compacting grindings with native soil, and overlaying the new base with new HMA. In addition, the project includes removal of the existing asphalt concrete pavement and underlying material and placing back new HMA pavement on an approximate 300-foot segment of 20th Avenue.

Additional improvements include reconstruction of cross gutters, and curb and gutter, construction of a concrete low water crossing dip section, placement of safety edge and shoulder backing to protect the outside edge of pavement, placement of thermoplastic crosswalk and pavement marking, roadside signs, and other associated work.

SUBMITTAL TO THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE, STATE OF CALIFORNIA

A portion of Dillon Road is in the City of Desert Hot Springs. The City of Desert Hot Springs portion includes the southern half of the road, from Palm Drive to Avenida Manzana (1/2 mile). The City of Desert Hot Springs was invited to participate in the resurfacing of their half of the road but declined.

The submitted plans and specifications have been approved as to form by County Counsel.

The bid documents include the following bid schedules of work:

The adjustment of the facilities owned by MSWD, are included as Alternative bid schedule 1. If MSWD approves the award of alternative bid schedule 1, as bid by the apparent low bidder, the cost for the work will be funded by MSWD through a reimbursement letter Agreement that will be executed by the Director of Transportation. The Director of Transportation has the authority to sign reimbursement Agreements up to \$100,000 per Minute Order dated November 19, 2019 (Agenda Item 3.25).

The Transportation Department will select the contractor based upon the lowest responsive and responsible bid.

Project Nos. D2-0096 – Dillon Road Resurfacing D1-0072 – Bubbling Wells Road Resurfacing

Environmental Findings

The proposed projects are exempt from CEQA under Section 15301 (c) – Existing Facilities exemption because the Dillon Road resurfacing and Bubbling Wells Road resurfacing do not create additional traffic lanes and involves negligible or no expansion of existing or former use of the existing roadway and associated facilities.

Impact on Citizens and Businesses

The purpose of this project is to replace existing deteriorated pavement with new hot mix asphalt for the approximate 1.5-mile segment of Dillon Road and 1.5-mile segment of Bubbling Wells Road in the Community of Southeast Desert Hot Springs to provide the public with a smooth, safe, and efficient paved roadway.

The work is scheduled to begin in summer 2024. The work will be phased to keep the road open during construction as much as possible and will take approximately two and a half months to complete.

The construction contract is estimated to cost approximately \$4,172,118. The County improvements will be funded with Gas Tax/SB-1, Road District IV, and MSWD funds.



PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The County of Riverside Transportation Department is proposing to resurface approximately 1.50 miles of Bubbling Wells Road from Dillon Road to 20th Avenue. Bubbling Wells Road is 24 feet wide and is a two-lane road with 60 to 85 feet of right of way. The proposed project will include grinding asphalt concrete in place, removing existing pavement, and paving with Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA) concrete pavement.

Additional improvements include but are not limited to:

- Re-grading within existing right-of-way to help drainage
- Utility adjustments
- Signing and striping of roadway

ENVIRONMENTAL ANALYSIS: The proposed project does not require additional right of way nor temporary construction easements (TCE). The project will extend the life of the road, which is a benefit to the traveling public. The project improvements will be within the existing footprint of the roadway and will not raise the roadway profile. There is no expansion of use of the road as a result of the project and will not raise the roadway profile.

These proposed project is subject to compliance with the Coachella Valley Multiple Species Habitat Conservation Plan (CVMSHCP) Area. In accordance with the CVMSHCP, necessary operation and maintenance along existing roadways are considered a covered activity outside conservation areas. Grading beyond the existing road pavement is limited to within the County right-of-way.

Additionally, this project is considered to be safety improvement under operation and maintenance, therefore it is a covered activity under the CVMSHCP. The project will comply with the construction guidelines outlined in the CVMSHCP as well as Best Management Practices (BMPs).

Section 15301 (c) - Existing Facilities - The project proposes to resurface approximately 1.5 miles of existing pavement along Bubbling Wells Road from Dillion Road to 20th Avenue; located in unincorporated location southeast of Desert Hot Springs in Riverside County. The project in its entirety is consistent with Section 15301(c) because it does not create additional traffic lanes and involves no expansion of use of the existing roadway and associated facilities.





PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The County of Riverside Transportation Department proposes to resurface approximately 1.47 miles of Dillon Road from Palm Drive to Mountain View Road (GPS location 33.924962, -116.501726). Dillon Road is a 40-to-84-foot, two lane arterial highway with 80 to 110 feet of right of way. The proposed project will include cold planing the existing pavement and placing Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA) pavement with crack seal for $\frac{1}{2}$ " to 1" cracks; removal of the existing asphalt and aggregate base in areas (dig out areas) and placing aggregate base, Hot Mix Asphalt base course, and HMA overlay to reconstruct the pavement section.

No additional right-of-way or temporary construction easements (TCE) will be required to construct the proposed improvements. The project improvements will be within the existing footprint of the roadway and will not raise the roadway profile.

The proposed project will include but is not limited to the following:

- Re-grading and placing a concrete low water crossing at Dillon Road east of Avenida Manzana within existing right-of-way (approximately 20-linear feet) and dirt ditch that drains east to west to the low point
- Utility adjustments and cleaning
- Signing and striping of roadway

ENVIRONMENTAL ANALYSIS:

This proposed project is subject to compliance with the Coachella Valley Multiple Species Habitat Conservation Plan (CVMSHCP) Area. In accordance with Section 7 of the Coachella Valley MSHCP, necessary operation and maintenance along existing roadways are considered a covered activity outside conservation areas. The concrete low water crossing and dirt ditch that is being constructed at the Morongo Wash crossing (western boundary of alignment) is needed to reduce erosion and sediment at this portion of roadway. Grading beyond the existing road pavement is limited to within the County right-of-way.

Additionally, this project is considered to be a safety improvement project under operation and maintenance, therefore it is a covered activity under the CVMSHCP. The project will comply with the construction guidelines outlined in the CVMSHCP as well as Best Management Practices (BMPs).


If tree and/or vegetation removal takes place during the typical migratory bird breeding season (February 1 – September 1), a preconstruction nesting survey will be conducted pursuant to the Migratory Bird Treaty Act of 1918 (MBTA) and California Fish and Game Codes Section 3500. 3503, 3503.5, 3513, and 3800. A pre-construction burrowing owl survey will be needed prior to start of construction to ensure no impact to burrowing owls that may be present within the area.

The County of Riverside Transportation Department has found that the above-described project is exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), based on the following:

Section 15301 (c) – Existing Facilities – The proposed project includes minimal road grading and resurfacing of approximately 1.47 miles of Dillon Road from Palm Drive to Mountain View Road (GPS location 33.924962, -116.501726). The proposed project is needed for the purpose of public safety. The project in its entirety is consistent with Section 15301(c) because the project is repair and maintenance of an existing street and sidewalk with negligible or no expansion of use.
