BACKGROUND:

Summary

The County of Riverside (County) is completing construction of Clinton Keith Road Extension from Leon Road to State Route 79. On March 5, 2002 (Agenda Item 3-41), the Board of Supervisors approved the Engineering Services Agreement between the County and CH2M Hill, Inc. for the preparation of Plans, Specifications and Estimates for the Clinton Keith Road Extension Project between Antelope Road and SR-79.

Work commenced on environmental studies for the project in 2002, followed by contract amendments as follows:

- The Board of Supervisors (BOS) approved Amendment No. 1, on November 2, 2004 (Agenda Item 3.30), and Amendment No. 2, on December 19, 2006 (Agenda Item 3.46), to the original agreement to modify the scope to incorporate additional environmental tasks and provide final engineering design services.
- On November 2, 2010 (Agenda Item 3.51), the BOS approved Amendment No. 3 to the Agreement which extended the termination date to June 30, 2014, continued design activities, support right-of-way acquisition, and develop construction strategies.
- On December 4, 2012 (Agenda Item 3.30), the BOS approved Amendment No. 4 to the Agreement to modify the scope to include revisions to the environmental documents and design plans for the next phase of work.
- On January 6, 2015 (Agenda Item 3.41), the BOS approved Amendment No. 5 to the Agreement to modify the scope of services to include updating technical studies and permit applications for newly created and identified environmental resources, and to include the scope services for an alternate bid for constructing a four lane facility, including additional environmental and design document updates.
- On January 24, 2017 (Agenda Item 3.11), the BOS approved Amendment No. 6 to the Agreement which adjusted the contract scope to include the additional design and construction support services for Phase 4 of the Clinton Keith Road Extension. The term of the agreement was also extended to December 30, 2019.
- On May 8, 2018 (Agenda Item 3.22), the BOS approved Amendment No. 7 to the Agreement which modified the scope to incorporate additional environmental services and final design tasks for Phase 3 of the project. Additional services were necessary due

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to changed site conditions and project phasing. The term of the agreement was also extended to December 31, 2022.

The Clinton Keith Road Extension Project was constructed in phases as funding became available. Phase 1 construction was completed by the City of Murrieta in 2012 which widened Clinton Keith Road, from Antelope Road to Whitewood Road, to the ultimate six (6) lane road width. Phase 2 and Phase 4 construction were completed simultaneously by the County in 2018 which widened Clinton Keith Road between Whitewood Road and Trois Valley Street from two (2) lanes to the ultimate six (6) lanes, added sidewalk, new traffic signals at Trois Valley Street and at Menifee Road, drainage modifications and a raised median were also constructed. Phase 3 of the Clinton Keith Road extension from Leon Road to SR-79 is nearing completion and improved the final segment of roadway to the ultimate six (6) lanes including a bridge over the French Valley Creek and traffic signal at Leon Road.

The habitat restoration and enhancement portion of the Phase 3 construction contract is required for compliance with the project environmental permits issued by California Department of Fish and Wildlife, the Regional Water Quality Control Board, and U.S. Army Corps of Engineers. The habitat restoration work was separated from the construction contract to facilitate construction closeout due to the required five-year plant establishment and maintenance period. On December 12, 2023 Habitat Restoration Sciences, Inc. was awarded a separate habitat restoration and enhancement construction contract (Agenda item 3.64).

Amendment 8 is now necessary to (1) extend the completion date of the Agreement set forth in Appendix B, Schedule of Services, through the projected completion date of the habitat restoration and enhancement construction contract in order for CH2M Hill to provide construction support activities for the habitat restoration and enhancement construction contract, and (2) increase CH2M Hill's Salary Rates as permitted in Appendix C, Budget, effective upon Board approval.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

The Clinton Keith Road Extension provides an alternate east-west road connection between SR-79 in French Valley and Interstate 215 in Wildomar. Providing a shorter, more direct route for goods and services.

Additional Fiscal Information

Amendment 8 to the Engineering Services Agreement between the County and CH2M Hill, will not change the existing cost and budget of the Agreement.

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AMENDMENT NO. 8 TO THE

ENGINEERING SERVICES AGREEMENT

FOR

CLINTON KEITH ROAD: I-215 TO SR-79 N

BETWEEN

COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE • TRANSPORTATION DEPARTMENT

AND

CH2M HILL, INC.

This Amendment No. 8 to the Engineering Services Agreement for Clinton Keith Road: I-215 to SR-79 N (hereinafter referred to as "Amendment No. 8") is made and entered into as of this 0.5 day of and between COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE, a political subdivision of the State of California, (hereinafter referred to as "COUNTY") and CH2M HILL, INC., a Florida corporation, (hereinafter referred to as "ENGINEER").

RECITALS

- A. COUNTY and ENGINEER have entered into a contract entitled "Engineering Services Agreement for Clinton Keith Road: I-215 to SR-79 N between County of Riverside ∘ Transportation Department and CH2M Hill, Inc." that is dated March 5, 2002 (Agenda Item 3.41), and amended on November 2, 2004 (Agenda Item 3.30), December 19, 2006 (Agenda Item 3.46), November 2, 2010 (Agenda Item 3.51), December 4, 2012 (Agenda Item 3.30), January 6, 2015 (Agenda Item 3.41), January 24, 2017 (Agenda Item 3.11), and May 8, 2018 (Agenda Item 3.22) (collectively, hereinafter referred to as "Agreement").
- B. The Agreement, as amended, provides the terms and conditions, scope of services, schedule, and budget for the performance of professional and technical services necessary to prepare an environmental document, project report, plans, specifications, and estimates for the Clinton Keith Road: I-215 to SR-79 N Project (hereinafter referred to as "PROJECT").
- C. On November 10, 2015 (Agenda Item 3.15), the Riverside County Board of Supervisors awarded a construction contract for Phase 2 of the PROJECT for the construction of a four-lane roadway segment from Whitewood

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Road to Trois Valley Street.

- D. On February 27, 2018 (Agenda Item 3.52), the Riverside County Board of Supervisors awarded a construction contract for Phase 4 of the PROJECT for the construction of the inside two lanes and median improvements within the Phase 2 limits to create a six lane facility from Whitewood Road to Trois Valley Street.
- E. On January 11, 2022 (Agenda Item 3.43), the Riverside County Board of Supervisors awarded a construction contract for Phase 3 of the PROJECT for the construction of a four-lane roadway segment which extends Clinton Keith Road from Leon Road to SR-79 completing the Clinton Keith Corridor improvements between I-215 and SR-79.
- F. The habitat restoration and enhancement portion of the previous construction contract that is required in accordance with the project environmental permit approvals issued by California Department of Fish and Wildlife, Regional Water Quality Control Board, and U.S. Army Corps of Engineers was separated from the construction contract to facilitate construction closeout due to the five-year plant establishment and maintenance period required for the habitat restoration and enhancement portion. Bids were opened on October 4, 2023 for the habitat restoration and enhancement construction contract and the construction contract was awarded to the lowest responsive responsible bidder at the end of 2023.
- G. The parties now desire to amend the Agreement to (1) extend the completion date of the Agreement set forth in Appendix B, Schedule of Services, through the projected completion date of the habitat restoration and enhancement construction contract in order for ENGINEER to provide construction support activities for the habitat restoration and enhancement construction contract, and (2) increase the ENGINEER's Salary Rates as permitted in Appendix C, Budget, effective upon signature of this Amendment No. 8 by the authorized representatives of both parties. There will be no overall increase to the maximum contract amount.

AGREEMENT

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants hereinafter contained, the parties agree as follows:

1. The second sentence of APPENDIX B • ARTICLE BI • INTRODUCTION of the Agreement is hereby amended to extend the completion date of the Agreement through June 30, 2025 as follows: "All covenants set forth in this Agreement shall be completed by June 30, 2025, unless extended by supplemental agreement."

- 3. Except to the extent specifically modified or amended hereunder, all of the terms, covenants and conditions of the Agreement, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect between the parties hereto.
- 4. This Amendment No. 8 shall become effective as of December 31, 2022.
- 5. This Amendment No. 8 may be executed in any number of counterparts, each of which shall be an original, but all of which together shall constitute one and the same instrument. Each party to this Amendment No. 8 agrees

to the use of electronic signatures, such as digital signatures that meet the requirements of the California Uniform Electronic Transactions Act (("CUETA") Cal. Civ. Code §§ 1633.1 to 1633.17), for executing this Amendment No. 8. The parties further agree that the electronic signatures of the parties included in this Amendment No. 8 are intended to authenticate this writing and to have the same force and effect as manual signatures. Electronic signature means an electronic sound, symbol, or process attached to or logically associated with an electronic record and executed or adopted by a person with the intent to sign the electronic record pursuant to the CUETA as amended from time to time. The CUETA authorizes use of an electronic signature for transactions and contracts among parties in California, including a government agency. Digital signature means an electronic identifier, created by computer, intended by the party using it to have the same force and effect as the use of a manual signature, and shall be reasonably relied upon by the parties. For purposes of this section, a digital signature is a type of "electronic signature" as defined in subdivision (i) of Section 1633.2 of the Civil Code.

IN WITNESS HEREOF, the parties hereto have caused this Amendment No. 8 to the Agreement to be duly executed this day and year first written above.




