BACKGROUND:

Summary

The District's Board approved a contract with the Contractor in the amount of \$7,558,650 as Agenda Item Number 11.3 (MT #16920) on August 24, 2021.

This is a District-led storm drain project featuring water conservation elements and is a joint project with the Beaumont-Cherry Valley Water District ("BCVWD"). The Project consists of 7,800 feet of pipe (54"-84") and recharge basin improvements. The primary objective of this Project is to provide flood protection to residents near Grand Avenue in Cherry Valley and increase groundwater recharge within the Project vicinity. Storm flows are generally collected in Bellflower Avenue, Winesap Avenue, Jonathan Avenue, Cherry Avenue, Nobel Street, and Grand Avenue and are safely conveyed westerly to an existing recharge basin owned and operated by BCVWD. Flows reaching the basins will help recharge the groundwater basin and become available for future pumping to meet the community's water needs.

Final inspection of the Project was made, and the Project was found to be complete according to plans and specifications. A brief Project description and location map is attached. The final price for the contract is \$7,623,324.90, which is within 1% the contract amount.

The District does not anticipate any claims for additional compensation from the Contractor.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

The Project improves flood protection and groundwater recharge for residents and businesses in the vicinity. The District constructed a segment of drainage infrastructure described in the District's Beaumont MDP, which remedies ongoing flooding problems in the area, thus resulting in positive impacts to residents and businesses.

Contract History and Price Reasonableness

Pursuant to Public Contract Code 21091, invitation of sealed bids was solicited by advertising in print and digital media.

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The final price for the contract is \$7,623,324.90, which is less than the contract amount.



BEAUMONT MDP LINE 16, STAGE 50 RECHARGE BASIN FEEDER PROJECT NO. 5-0-00201



The Beaumont MDP Line 16, Stage 50 Recharge Basin Feeder project is located in the unincorporated community of Cherry Valley just north of the city of Beaumont. In partnership with Beaumont Cherry Valley Water District (BCVWD) the project will collect dry—weather and stormwater flows into an underground storm drain system and convey such waters to BCVWD's existing water conservation recharge ponds located to the east of Beaumont High School. If and when the recharge ponds capacity is exceeded, emergency outlets will safely convey water into the adjacent District facility known as Noble Creek.
