2. Approve the issuance of a check in the amount of \$753,525 to California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) as a security deposit until such time offsite mitigation can be performed;
3. Approve the plans and specifications for the construction of the Gilman Springs Road Phase 6 Safety Project, in the Eastern Moreno Valley and Gilman Hot Springs areas of the County of Riverside; and
4. Authorize the Clerk of the Board to advertise for bids to be received by the office of the office of the Director of Transportation and Land Management at the Transportation Annex located at 3525 14th Street, Riverside, CA 92501. All bids must be received up to the hour of 2:00 p.m., Wednesday, April 10, 2024 at which time bids will be opened.



BACKGROUND:

Summary

The Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) provides for the construction of the Gilman Springs Road Phase 6 Safety Project, in the Eastern Moreno Valley and Gilman Hot Springs areas of the County of Riverside. The project limits are from approximately 1.7 miles south of Alessandro Boulevard to approximately 1 mile south of Bridge Street and covers approximately 4.3 miles.

Within the project limits, Gilman Springs Road is classified as an Arterial Highway in the circulation element of the County of Riverside General Plan. Current roadway consists of two lanes of undivided traffic with one lane in each direction and 2-foot-wide paved shoulders.

The proposed safety improvements include widening of Gilman Springs Road to accommodate a single twelve-foot lane in each direction with approximately five-foot paved shoulders with rumble strips to help alert drivers who may stray from the travel lanes, additional five-foot graded dirt shoulders, a 4-foot-wide double yellow striped center median with reflective delineators and rumble strips, and a passing lane for the north/west direction of approximately 1.3 miles in length.

Additional improvements include replacing an existing reinforced concrete box (RCB) culvert located approximately 150-foot west of Bridge Street with a wider RCB culvert to create a wildlife crossing bridge, installation of 8-foot high wildlife fence with jump-outs to allow wildlife to escape from the roadway, extension of various existing corrugated steel pipe culverts to accommodate the additional pavement width, removal of existing metal beam guardrail, installation of new metal beam guardrail at various locations within the project limits, minor modification of the existing traffic signal at Bridge Street, and other associated work.

The submitted plans and specifications have been approved as to form by County Counsel.

Environmental Findings

The County of Riverside is the lead agency for the approval of the CEQA document for the Project. By Minute Order dated September 13, 2022 (Agenda Item 3.20), the County of Riverside Board of Supervisors adopted the Initial Study/Mitigated Negative Declaration for the Gilman Springs Road Phase 6 Safety Project. The Notice of Determination was posted with the Riverside County Recorder's Office on September 16, 2022.

Mitigation efforts to offset impacts on natural resources by the project will occur offsite. However, the location for the mitigation is currently flooded due to a series of recent storms. California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) will accept a security deposit in good faith that County will initiate mitigation efforts when possible. Security deposit funds will then be released and used toward the mitigation work.

A Categorical Exclusion in accordance with 23 USC 327 for NEPA was executed on September 2, 2022, by State Department of Transportation (Caltrans).

Impact on Citizens and Businesses

The proposed improvements will enhance safety and traffic operations by increasing the width of the median, widening the shoulders, adding a passing lane, and installing new pavement markings and delineation to help with visual and audible warnings. Widening of paved shoulders will provide a safe recovery area for vehicles as well as providing a refuge area for vehicles that need to pull off the roadway. Passing lane improvements will allow motorists an opportunity to safely pass slower moving vehicles. The project will also replace existing deteriorated pavement with new hot mix asphalt to provide the public with a smooth paved roadway surface that will enhance the overall safety and efficiency of vehicular traffic.

Full closure of Gilman Springs Road for fourteen consecutive calendar days will be necessary to complete the construction of the wildlife crossing bridge. During the fourteen-calendar day road closure, local residential / business access will be provided, and through traffic will be directed to use an alternate detour route.

The work is anticipated to begin in the summer of 2024. The work will be phased to keep the road open during construction as much as possible and will take approximately six months to complete.

Additional Fiscal Information

The construction contract is estimated to cost approximately \$17,082,033 and will be funded with Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP) funds for which the Department successfully obtained, and Gas Tax / HUTA funds.

A security deposit in the amount of \$753,525 to California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) will be required for future mitigation efforts to be completed by the Transportation Department. The security deposit must occur prior to the beginning of construction.

There are no General Funds used in this project.

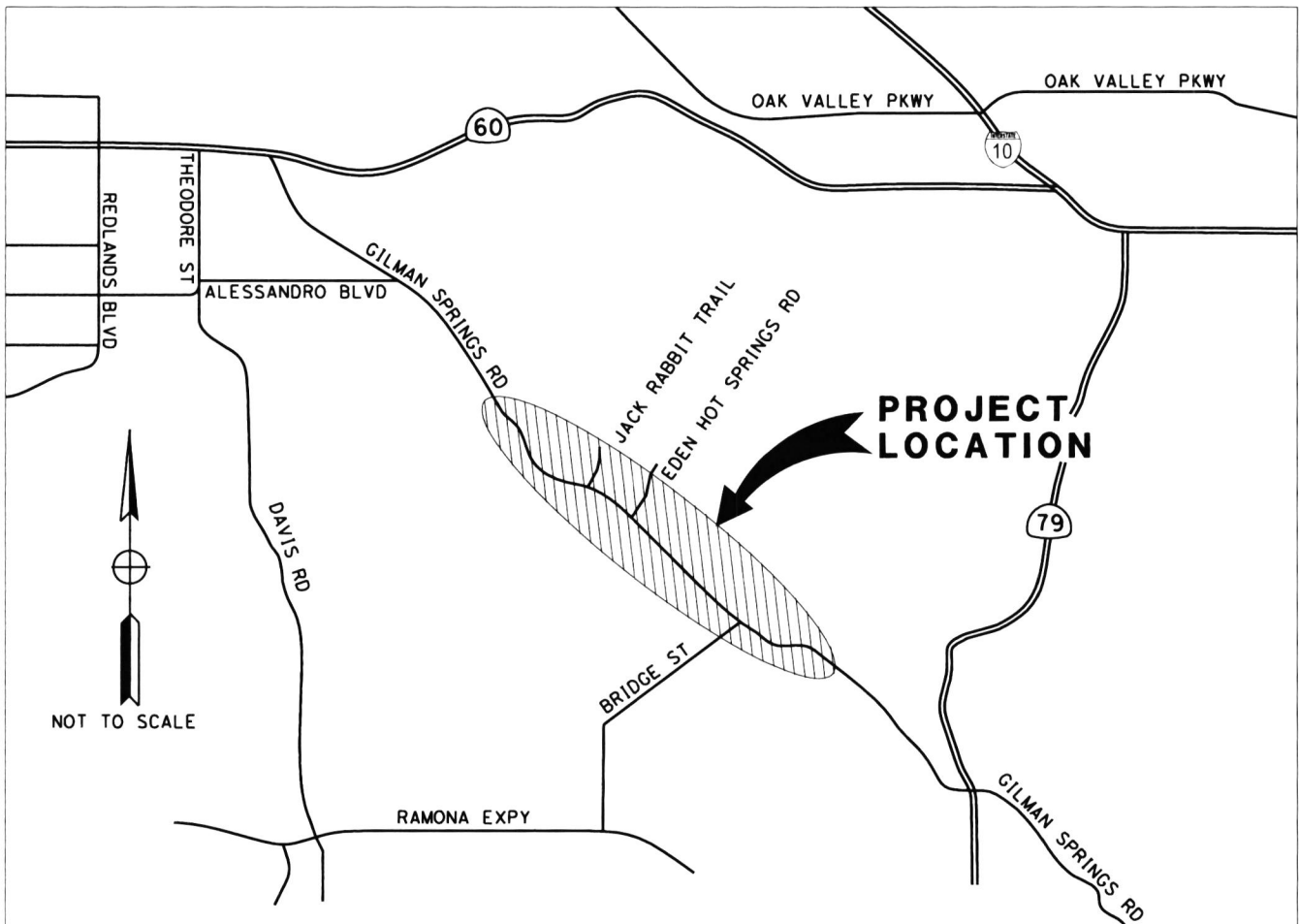
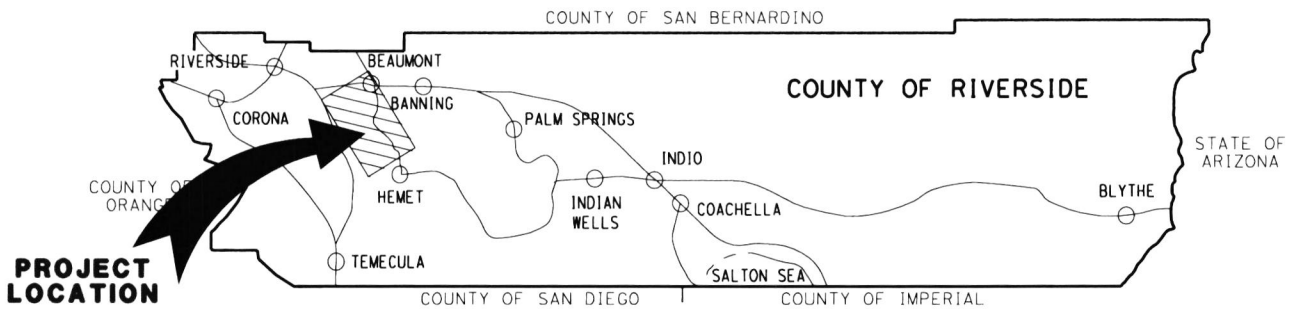
