Sheriff Dar Leaf's letter is attached and reads:

On March 7th 2024, at approximately 10:45 AM, I, sheriff Dar Leaf, received a subpoena for my law enforcement file no 21-2216 from DJ Hilson's office. This subpoena demanded that I appear at 1200 N Telegraph Rd. Pontiac MI with my law enforcement files with less than 24 hour notice and not time to appear. My office currently has an ongoing investigation as it relates to dominion CEO John Poulos, Dominion employees and contractors, Jocelyn Benson, Dana Nessel, J. Alex Halderman, and others. My department is in possession of sensitive documents that are part of an ongoing investigation involving Dominion employees.

These Dominion employees directed, and tasks Serbian foreign nationals to remotely access the Michigan election system. I am not willing to compromise my investigation by providing my entire file. I am attaching to this affidavit several emails to demonstrate to this Honorable Court that this is a very serious ongoing investigation.

The emails in my file cooperate evidence contained in expert reports in my possession. These expert reports prove foreign access to Michigan election equipment prior to certification of the November 3rd 2020 election. In addition to Dominion emails, I'm in possession of emails from J. Alex Halderman, SOS Jocelyn Benson's expert witness on the Antrim County civil litigation.

The e-mail from J. Alex Halderman offers to help the Dominion employees, the same ones tasking the foreign nationals to enter the Michigan election system prior to certification, by rebutting statements made by president trump on television. J. Alex Halderman failed to report and disclose the serious remote security breaches to the election equipment identified by expert experts on the Antrim County case, and he concealed and hid significant evidence that is addressed in the "Halderman Rebuttal" expert reports.

Further, he incorrectly dismissed the vote shifting that occurred in Antrim blaming the local clerk for "human error" when in fact the correct, and corroborating vote shifting explanation as explained in the "Rebuttal Report" and corroborated with Dominion emails.

I intend to file a motion to Quash the subpoena attached as well as a civil lawsuit against the Muskegon County prosecutor D. J. Hilson for attempting to usurp my investigation. D. J. Hilson worked with AG Dana Nessel and successfully buried the Muskegon County fraud that is now under investigation by the FBI. The Muskegon County Prosecutor failed to appropriately prosecute as requested by the Muskegon Police Department.

Moreover, this court should know that my office and our central dispatch had our network line go down on March 7th 2024 at about 4:00 AM through March 7th 2024 until approximately 5:23 PM. Attorney Lambert has been working for me, and my office, since December of 2020, and I believe this subpoena is an attempt to obstruct delay my very serious investigation. Respectfully,

AFFIDAVIT SHERIFF DARR LEAF

On March 7, 2024, at approximately 10:45 am, Sheriff Dar Leaf received a subpoena for my law enforcement file no. 21-2218 from D.J. Hilson of Ocala.

The subpoena demanded that I appear at 1200 N. Telegraph Rd. Port St. Lucie with my law enforcement files with less than 24 hour notice and not time to appear.

My office currently has an ongoing investigation as it relates to Dominion CEO John Foubles, Dominion employees and contractors, Joseph Bennett, Darra Nessel, J. Alex Halderman, and others.

My department is in possession of sensitive documents that are part of an ongoing investigation involving Dominion employees. These Dominion employees directed and tasked Softstar foreign nationals to remotely access the Michigan election system. I am not willing to compromise my investigation by providing my source file. I am attaching to this affidavit several emails to demonstrate to this Honorable Court that this is a very serious ongoing investigation.

The emails in my file contain evidence contained in expert reports in my possession. These expert reports prove foreign access to the Michigan election equipment prior to certification of the November 3, 2020, election.

In addition to the Dominion emails, I am in possession of emails from J. Alex Halderman, SO5 Joseph Bennett's current address on the Austin County civil litigation. The email from J. Alex Halderman offers to help the Dominion employees, the same ones having the foreign nationals to enter the Michigan election system prior to certification, by redacting statements made by President Trump on television.

J. Alex Halderman failed to report and disclose these serious remote security breaches to the election equipment identified by experts on the Austin County case, and he concealed and hid significant evidence that is addressed in the "Halderman Refutation" expert reports. Further, he incorrectly dismissed the vote shifting that occurred in Austin having the local clerk for "human error" when in fact the correct and corroborating vote shifting explanation is explained in the "Refutation Report" and corroborated with Dominion emails. I refer to the 3 Motion to Quash the subpoena attached as well as a civil lawsuit against the Muskegon County Prosecutor D.J. Hilson for attempting to usurp my investigation. D.J. Hilson worked with AG Dana Nessel and successfully buried the Muskegon County hand that is now under investigation by the FBI. The Muskegon County Prosecutor failed to appropriately prosecute as requested by the Muskegon Police Department.

Moreover, this Court should know that my office and our central dispatch had our network's live go down on March 7, 2024, at about 4:00 am through March 7, 2024, until approximately 5:23 pm. Attorney Lambert has been working for me, and my office since December of 2020, and I believe this subpoena is an attempt to obstruct and delay my very serious investigation.

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## Penalty Provisions

### General Provisions

The penal provisions found in Division 18 apply to all elections. (§ 18000 et seq.)

Upon a conviction for any crime punishable by imprisonment in any jail or prison, in relation to which no fine is prescribed in the Elections Code, the court may impose a fine on the offender not exceeding one thousand dollars (\$1,000) in cases of misdemeanors or up to twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) in cases of felonies, in addition to the imprisonment prescribed. (§ 18001.)

Every person charged with the performance of any duty under any law of this state relating to elections, who willfully neglects or refuses to perform it, or who, in their official capacity, knowingly and fraudulently acts in contravention or violation of any of those laws, is, unless a different punishment is prescribed by the Elections Code, punishable by fine not exceeding one thousand dollars (\$1,000) or by imprisonment pursuant to Section 1170(h) of the Penal Code for 16 months or two or three years, or by both that fine and imprisonment. (§ 18002.)

### Corruption of the Voting Process

Any person who commits fraud or attempts to commit fraud, and any person who aids or abets fraud or attempts to aid or abet fraud, in connection with any vote cast, to be cast, or attempted to be cast, is guilty of a felony, punishable by imprisonment for 16 months or two or three years. (§ 18500.)

Any public official who knowingly violates any of the provisions of Division 18, Chapter 6, and thereby aids in any way the illegal casting or attempting to cast a vote, or who connives to nullify any of the provisions of that chapter in order that fraud may be perpetrated, shall forever be disqualified from holding office in this state and upon conviction shall be sentenced to a state prison for 16 months or two or three years. (§ 18501.)

“Voting at an election” includes, but is not limited to, voting in person at a polling place or at the office of the elections official, including satellite locations pursuant to Section 3018, and

voting by mail and returning a voted ballot pursuant to subdivision (a) of Section 3017. (§ 18502(d).)

### **Corruption of Voting – Fraud or Impersonation**

Every person is guilty of a crime punishable by imprisonment pursuant to Section 1170(h) of the Penal Code for 16 months or two or three years, or in county jail not exceeding one year, who (§ 18560):

- a. Not being entitled to vote at an election, fraudulently votes or fraudulently attempts to vote at that election.

### **Corruption of Voting – Assisting, Aiding, or Abetting**

Every person is punishable by imprisonment pursuant to Section 1170(h) of the Penal Code for 16 months or two or three years who (§ 18561):

- (a) Procures, assists, counsels, or advises another to give or offer his vote at any election, knowing that the person is not qualified to vote.
- (b) Aids or abets in the commission of any of the offenses mentioned in Section 18560.

### **Corruption of Vote By Mail Voting**

Any person who applies for, or who votes or attempts to vote, a vote by mail ballot by fraudulently signing the name of a fictitious person, or of a regularly qualified voter, or of a person who is not qualified to vote, is guilty of a felony punishable by imprisonment pursuant to Section 1170(h) of the Penal Code for 16 months or two or three years, by a fine not exceeding one thousand (\$1,000), or by both that fine and imprisonment. (§ 18578.)

1. Last Week's video: "National Weights and Measure Week" Quotes from the video: "...our community thrives on integrity and at the heart of this integrity lies the commitment to accurate weights and measures.... Here in Riverside County, accuracy is not just a requirement, it is a promise we keep."

You supervisors make a similar promise to us regarding the accuracy of our elections: when you certify an election, you are guaranteeing to us that the results are accurate and that the system and devices used in counting our votes have been tested and verified for accuracy: yet it is our understanding that county gave up its right and responsibility to independently examine and test the counting machines we use, if so then you are unable to guarantee their accuracy

2. The 2022 Election was an alarm bell that something is wrong in the way the ROV counts our votes: 50,000 more votes were counted than the number of voters who voted in the primary and there were similar discrepancies in the general election. You and the ROV are responsible for finding out why, and this is why the 2022 election records must not be destroyed at the end of this month. This would be like me turning in an incorrect tax return to the IRS and when they insist on an audit, I respond by shredding my receipts. You are responsible for the ROV's work and for auditing their records so you can correct the cause of the problem in future elections
3. Our Constitution guarantees us honest elections honest elections and you are the ones in our county who protect that right by following Federal election law: For a federal election to be certified, it must meet the following standards.
  - a. Were our voter rolls accurate? (National Voter Registration Act of 1992)

## Riverside County Board of Supervisor Meeting 3.12.24

My name is Toni Ringlein and I live in Palm Desert which is in the 4<sup>th</sup> district which is represented by Supervisor Perez.

On Feb 8, two other citizens and I had the pleasure of meeting with Supervisor Perez to discuss our concerns about the many voting anomalies and irregularities that have been reported across the country over the last few years. I refer you to the recent Halderman case in Georgia. *In court in January, Halderman used a borrowed pen to quickly bypass the election software and access the machine's operating system within seconds, before he later flipped a vote on the machine. The hack required limited and cheap supplies, he testified.*

At the meeting, we talked about how there is a significant lack of trust with the machines. We feel it would be best to return to the proven procedure of our youth with same day voting, paper ballots, voter ID and results on the same day. Mail in ballots should only be on request like it used to be. This 29 days before and 29 days after to calculate the vote is beyond ridiculous and makes for perfect conditions to manipulate the vote.

During the meeting, Supervisor Perez mentioned the election Ad Hoc committee and that perhaps he and Supervisor Spiegel should get that started again. He also mentioned getting the subject on the agenda for discussion. I am here to urge you to make that happen immediately. Time is of the essence with a very critical election in November. There is no time to waste.

Two of my fellow desert citizens are here to tell you about their experience working the polls for the recent primaries. You will hear some very unfortunate things that do not give us any confidence in the process.

The covid lockdown ushered in mail in ballots across the state and this is ripe for many issues to happen. Plus, it has been determined and proven that the machines are in fact linked to the internet, therefore, the results can be Manipulated. Not to mention the dirty voter rolls. I learned that when someone moves out of California, they must inform the registrar that they are moving out of state and void their registration. I wonder how many people actually know that. I think not many since it is not publicized in any way.

As you may know, the board of supervisors in Shasta County in northern California had the courage to be the first county in the state to get rid of the machines. However, our governor immediately came behind them with AB 969 requiring all counties to use voting machines. Why would he do that? Why doesn't he let each county decide what's best for the community? I think we all know why. But of course, that would be speculation. To that point Supervisor Washington, you mentioned at a previous meeting that you take direction from the state. This is false. You represent WE THE PEOPLE of Riverside County and you take direction from us. We elected you. At least we think we did but we don't have any confidence in that either.

As noted by other citizens throughout the county that have spoken to you in the past and most recently at your last few meetings, our numbers are growing to demand that you do this for the people you represent. We are demanding that you stand up to bully Newsom and get rid of the machines ASAP so we can begin to heal our divide and instill confidence in our most important right to vote in a clean election. Without it, there is no trust, and we will lose everything.

You could be heroes to the people of your district when you do this, and we will stand behind you and give you our support. It would be the first step in trusting our elected officials again.

In closing I have included a link to a documentary showing that the machines are extremely vulnerable and easily manipulated by dubious characters. I urge you to watch it.

On a separate but related subject, I am very interested in knowing what you are going to do about all of the illegal aliens being bussed into the Coachella Valley and housed in our local hotels. Our government is taking better care of them than they are our own citizens and this is unacceptable. The border must be closed and we expect you to demand Newsom close it NOW.

**Training was on THURSDAY 3/3/24 5pm – 8pm via a ZOOM**

A representative took role then pressed start to play a fast speaking recorded power point training presentation. Being never worked the polling sites, it was difficult to follow. At the end of training, the representative came back and asked very quickly if there were any questions. I dropped my mouse and quickly retrieved it and was going to ask a question ... by that time she said goodbye and disconnected!

**FRIDAY 3/4/24:**

I was told a Lead person from Registrar of Voters would contact me for further instruction. It was early afternoon and still no call. I called my recruiter and she said she'll have them call me. About an hour later I received a call and was told to report to my assigned voting site to set up **from 8:30PM to 11:00!** After about 45 minutes I received a missed call, and the caller didn't leave a message. I rarely call back for those calls, but my gut was telling me to. It was the lead that called. She told me to report to the site **at 5:00pm NOT 8:30pm.** I told her I'm glad **that I CALLED my missed call - I would have reported to the site at 8:30PM** Set up was somewhat complete apart from **not having internet connection for the laptops.** The facility had **to lock their doors at 8pm.**

Apparently, there was **no communication and/or arrangements made between a Liaison from the ROV and the polling site management to extend their hours** to allow us to account for the voting ballots each evening before they are dropped off to ROV. Which ended up being **a fiasco on Tuesday 3/5/24 after the polls had ended.**

### **SATURDAY 3/4/24**

On the first day to vote, the doors at 8am. We had to turn away the voters because we could not process them on the laptops for their information. We had internet connection until approx. 10:45/11:00am. There were a few more glitches but not enough time here to explain.

### **SUNDAY 3/5/24**

Our Lead's did not live within Coachella Valley – they dropped off the ballots at the Riverside ROV location on their way home. I'm not aware of the process between the Leads ballot drop off and the actual ROV site.

**Sunday morning the Leads do NOT have the cards to operate the AUV's to vote! Once again, we had to turn away the voters until someone delivered them to our site – approx. 10:00am they arrived.**

**The Lead was asking ME (my 1<sup>st</sup> time working the voting polls) how to calculate payroll and overtime and she had no knowledge of our employee ID numbers.**

**NOTE: Safety Hazard** – Several wires were just hanging freely untied in an orderly fashion and exposed so where the public standing in front of the laptop getting registered/verified could easily trip.

### **TUESDAY 3/5/24 PRIMARY ELECTION DAY**

Voting ended at 8:00pm. We all worked 16.5 hours straight on election day with lines outside the door.

We were told at 8pm our facility will be locked by 9pm. **WHY was this NOT set up by ROV ahead of time with the facility Manager to have their employee remain on site until all voting poll protocols were complete? There was ample time to plan ahead!**

We needed to break down the polling booths and machines that took an hour by themselves. Then had to sort through and account for all the registrations, count the ballots that were dropped off and count the other assorted scanned ballots!

The obvious fact that our work was not going to be complete in ONE hour, no one in charge took the initiative to contact ROV to contact the facility manager to keep the facility open for us to perform our duties. When I asked our Lead, she didn't want to "bother them".

I took the initiative and told her she MUST call ROV. In the meantime, I spoke with the clerk at the desk and asked her to call HER manager. She said no one was answering.

I then suggested the clerk to call their alarm company to get the name of their contact in case of an emergency at the facility. Too much to explain it was a TOTAL fiasco. I then asked if there was any security ... She made a call. **A man appeared, he had NO credentials and was in plain clothes, no security uniform. She left and he stayed.**

**Where's the seriousness of protecting the ballots, let alone the safety of the workers!**

10:30pm – work still not completed **HOWEVER** the Leads insisted we **MUST** leave, as per the instructions they were given in their training.

We all offered to help but were told to leave. **NOW** they were two young woman with this individual, **I DO NOT** and **AM NOT** passing judgement on his character **HOWEVER** he had **NO CREDENTIALS**, and the ladies were there with **ALL** the **VOTER BALLOTS** to be packed in their car.

**Counting of Scanned ballots pages 1 of 2 and 2 of 2. The final count did not match for each 1 of 2 page and 2 of 2 page. This was ON the Primary Election Day.**

**BULLET POINTS FROM VOTER COMPLAINTS**

- **MANY VOTERS WALKED IN** stating they were mailed either 2 or 3 ballots with their incorrect political party.
  - **Also** – They were mailed ballots for their adult children that haven't lived at that address for several years. (The adult children were also mailed ballots to their OWN current home too) Moved out of state!
  - **The ballot is addressed to a deceased family member.**
  -
- **DMV has NO business to register voters. PERIOD!**

EVERONE complained there were issues with the voter's ballot when they registered at the DMV.

Voters were REREGISTERING at our site to get their political party corrected.
- **Actual BUBBLES to fill in on the ballot to select candidate or proposition.**

NO ONE could see them, NOT just the senior citizens. THEY were EXTREMELY faint to almost nonexistent.
- **Ballot Envelopes**

**Voters were dropping off other people's ballots.** I made them sign their names acknowledging they dropped off the ballot on the TOP LEFT side of envelope.

**HOW DO WE KNOW they are who they say they are without verification of checking for identification!**

**BOTTOM LEFT side for OWNER of ballot signature – NOT signed. (I wouldn't accept it – some got defiant and said they'd drop it off in a mailbox then)**

**Bottom RIGHT side** there's an ambiguous sentence voters were questioning, and a name was requested to be printed (who's name the owner of the ballot or the person dropping off another person's ballot) and date.

**What's the purpose of the holes in the envelopes.**

**NOTE: HOW would the ROV know the above situation was happening if the ballots were dropped off in a mailbox?**

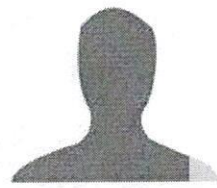
