

BACKGROUND: Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

1. The donation to the Riverside Art Museum (\$1,500.00) will be used for The Cheech art sculpture in honor of Ofelia Valdez-Yeager.
2. The donation to Trinity Therapeutic Riding Center, Inc. (\$2,000.00) will be used to install a mounting ramp at the center. The center helps people with trauma, pain, and abandonment feelings by using horses as therapy. The mount will be used to get students on and off their horse from a wheelchair making horseback riding accessible to more people.
3. The donation to Corona Life Services / Zoi (\$1,500.00) will be used for Zoi's Gala for Life which funds allow them to continue offering free medial care, education, and support services to the community they serve.
4. The donation to the Rotary Club of Corona (\$5,000.00) will be used for Lobsterfest which funds help support other local non-profit organizations in Corona such as the YMCA, Settlement House and Corona Police Explores to name a few.
