BACKGROUND:

Summary

By Minute Order dated January 9, 2024 (Agenda Item 3.62), the County of Riverside Board of Supervisors authorized the Clerk of the Board to advertise for the construction of the Avenue 48 Widening Project. The limits of the Avenue 48 Widening Project are from Van Buren Street to Dillon Road.

Avenue 48 is an east-west major arterial roadway in the City of Coachella, City of Indio, and the County of Riverside. Avenue 48, between Van Buren Street and Dillon Road, currently consists of two vehicular lanes (one lane in each direction) and a striped two-way left turn median. The northerly half of Avenue 48 is in the jurisdictional boundary of the County and the City of Indio, and the southerly half is in the jurisdictional boundary of the City of Coachella.

The Coachella Valley Association of Governments (CVAG), the City of Coachella, the City of Indio, and the County will widen Avenue 48 between Van Buren Street and Dillon Road (Project) to alleviate congestion and help improve traffic circulation. The improvements will add one westbound lane and one eastbound lane with a raised concrete median. In addition, curb, gutter, and sidewalk will be constructed in the westbound direction and a five-foot wide bike lane will be provided in the eastbound direction.

Additional improvements include construction of Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) compliant curb ramps, cross gutter and spandrels, residential driveways, construction of pavement safety edge to protect the outside edge of pavement, reconstruction of private property improvements (fences, planters, concrete curbs, asphalt and concrete driveway connections, etc.), installation of traffic striping, thermoplastic crosswalks and pavement markings, installation of traffic signs, modifications to the existing traffic signals at Van Buren Street and Dillon Road, and other associated work.

During the advertisement period, one addendum was issued to all registered plan holders as a supplement to the plans and specifications. Bidders were required to acknowledge and take into account the issued addendum on their contractor's Bid in order to be considered for award.

The addendum was issued to clarify and modify the approved contract documents. The addendum is attached and designated as Addendum No. 1.

The Contract includes the following schedules of work:

Base Bid Schedule A: Avenue 48 within County and City of Indio jurisdiction
Base Bid Schedule B: Avenue 48 within City of Coachella jurisdiction
Alternative Bid Schedule 1: Valley Sanitary District (VSD) Facility Adjustments

VSD has accepted the bid prices proposed by Granite for Alternative Bid Schedule 1 which includes adjustment of nine (9) manhole covers, and the cost for the work will be reimbursed by VSD through reimbursement Agreement. The Director of Transportation has the authority to sign reimbursement Agreements up to \$100,000 per Minute Order dated November 19, 2019 (Agenda Item 3.25).

The contractor, Granite, is qualified to perform the work as outlined in the bid, has executed the contract, and has provided bonds and insurance documents which meet the requirements of the contract documents.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

The project will alleviate congestion, and improve operational efficiency for pedestrians and local traffic on Avenue 48. Widening the roadway will improve pedestrian and vehicular traffic circulation and access for motorists, residents, businesses, emergency service providers, nearby institutions such as schools, and public transportation. The project is consistent with the County, City of Coachella, and City of Indio General Plans to meet current and future traffic demands.

The work is scheduled to begin in May/June 2024. The work will be phased to keep the road open during construction as much as possible and will take approximately four months to complete.

SUPPLEMENTAL:

Additional Fiscal Information

Construction is expected to be completed in Fiscal Year 2024/2025 and will be funded with Transportation Uniform Mitigation Fee (CVAG), County of Riverside, City of Coachella, City of Indio, and Valley Sanitary District funds.

Per Agency Reimbursement Agreement and Amendments (by Minute Orders: June 20, 2017 – Agenda Item 3.41; April 27, 2021 – Agenda Item 3.32, June 13, 2023 – Agenda Item 3.30), CVAG agreed to pay 75% of all qualified Project costs (including design, environmental, right-of-way, and construction) not to exceed \$4,700,000.

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The County's proportional share for the Project will be funded with Gas Tax/HUTA Funds. The Cities of Coachella and Indio are responsible for funding their proportional share for the Project.

The proposed budget as shown on Attachment "A" includes Contract award amount and other associated costs.

There are no General Funds used in this project.


Contract History and Price Reasonableness

A total of four bids were received on Wednesday January 31, 2024 ranging from \$2,337,000 to \$3,081,575. The basis for the selection of a contractor is the lowest responsive and responsible bid. The lowest responsive and responsible bid was submitted by Granite in the amount of \$2,337,000, which is \$251,630 (9.7%) below the engineer's cost estimate.

The Transportation Department recommends the award of the contract to Granite in the amount of \$2,337,000.

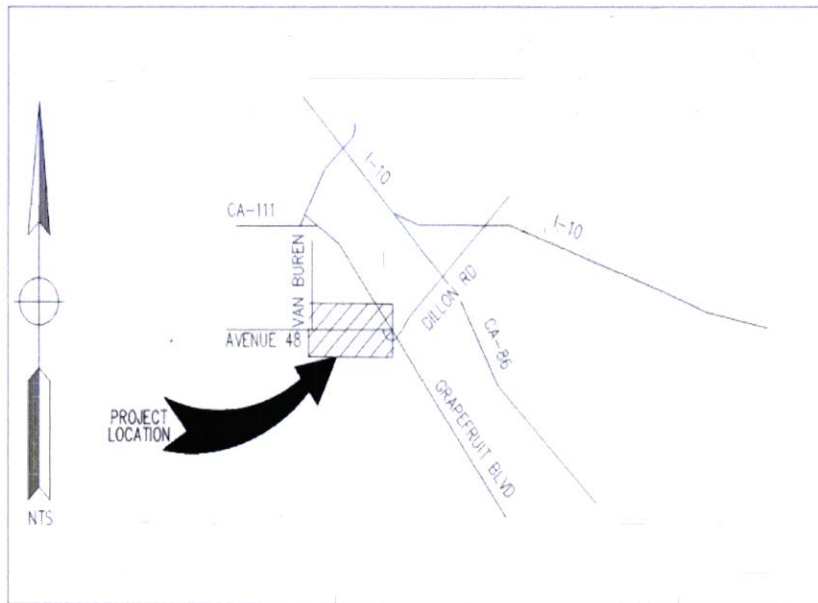
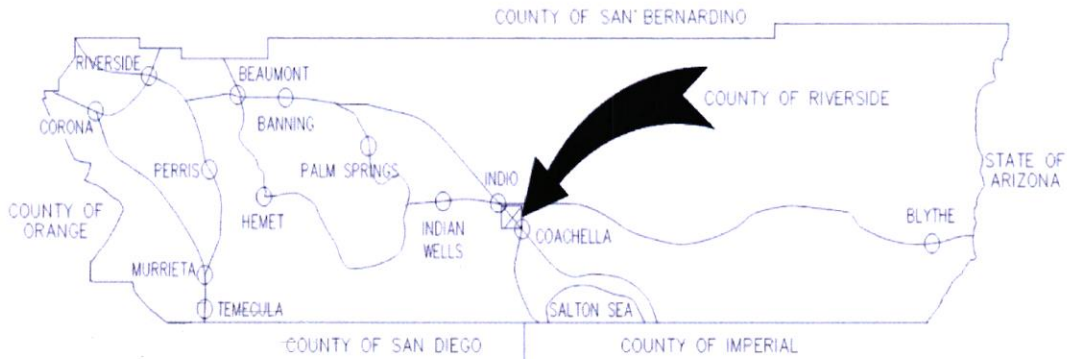

Such removal shall be by wet abrasive blasting, hydro-blasting or vacuum blasting, and shall comply with AQMD regulations.

Pavement markings shall be removed by grinding a rectangular area, rather than just lettering or markings, so the old message cannot be identified.
