4. Approve the project proposed budget as shown on Attachment "A".



BACKGROUND:

Summary

By Minute Order dated November 28, 2023 (Agenda Item 3.47), the County of Riverside Board of Supervisors authorized the Clerk of the Board to advertise for the construction of the Lakepointe Drive Reconstruction Project. The limits on Lakepointe Drive are from Indiana Avenue to the southern connection of Sun Summit Drive.

Lakepointe Drive is a two-lane facility that travels in the North-South directions with a road width between 40 feet and 60 feet wide with curb and gutter on both sides and is currently classified as a local road. The area in the immediate vicinity includes a residential area with single family dwellings and hilly open spaces.

Roadway reconstruction is needed due to the deteriorated pavement condition. The reconstruction project consists of removing existing asphalt concrete pavement and underlying material and placing back new Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA). Where base and/or subgrade failure has occurred, the existing asphalt concrete pavement and underlying material will be removed and placed back with new HMA over aggregate base, with a geogrid placed between the aggregate base and natural soil to provide subgrade enhancement thus preventing premature failure of the pavement structure.

Additional improvements include construction of a subsurface drainage system and reconstruction of Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) compliant concrete access ramps, sidewalk, driveways, curb and gutter, and cross gutters. Additional roadway features include placement of thermoplastic crosswalk and pavement marking, roadside signs, and other associated work.

On March 11, 2021, President Biden signed the \$1.9 trillion American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) of 2021 into law. To accelerate recovery from the economic and health impacts of the COVID-19 pandemic, the County of Riverside was provided approximately \$480 million. The Executive Office in conjunction with the Board of Supervisors developed a plan to disburse these funds based on the principles of providing recovery funding to those sectors of our economy and

society that are struggling most to recover from the pandemic; have a constituent and community based focus; provide a vehicle for transformational investment in our County's recovery from COVID-19; provide for countywide equity; and focus on one time investments, rather than funding ongoing operational costs. As a result of these principles, the Lakepointe Drive Resurfacing project was selected as a recipient of these funds by Minute Order 3.2 of the 2/27/24 Board of Supervisors Meeting Agenda.

During the advertisement period, two addenda were issued to all registered plan holders as a supplement to the plans and specifications. Bidders were required to acknowledge and take into account the issued addenda on their contractor's Bid in order to be considered for award.

The addenda were issued to supplement, clarify and modify the approved contract documents. The addenda are attached and designated as Addendum No. 1 and Addendum No. 2.

The Contract includes the following schedules of work:

Base Bid Schedule: Lakepointe Drive Reconstruction
Alternative Bid Schedule 1: Western Municipal Water District (WMWD) Facility Adjustments

WMWD has accepted the bid prices proposed by All American Asphalt for Alternative Bid Schedule 1 which includes adjustments of sixteen (16) sewer manhole covers, and the cost for the work will be reimbursed by WMWD through reimbursement Agreement. The Director of Transportation has the authority to sign reimbursement Agreements up to \$100,000 per Minute Order dated November 19, 2019 (Agenda Item 3.25).

The contractor, All American Asphalt, is qualified to perform the work as outlined in the bid, has executed the contract, and has provided bonds and insurance documents which meet the requirements of the contract documents.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

The purpose of this project is to replace existing deteriorated pavement with new hot mix asphalt for an approximate 0.82-mile segment of Lakepointe Drive in the Community of Lake Hills to provide the public with a smooth paved roadway for vehicular traffic.

The work is scheduled to begin in late spring 2024 and will take approximately three months to complete.

Additional Fiscal Information

Construction is expected to be completed in Fiscal Year 2024/2025 and will be funded with State Exchange, American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA), and WMWD funds.

The proposed budget as shown on Attachment "A" includes Contract award amount and other associated costs.

There are no General Funds used in this project.

Contract History and Price Reasonableness

A total of seven bids were received on Wednesday January 17, 2024 ranging from \$1,761,383 to \$2,653,806. The basis for the selection of a contractor is the lowest responsive and responsible bid. The lowest responsive and responsible bid was submitted by All American Asphalt in the amount of \$1,761,383, which is \$281,418 (13.8%) below the engineer's cost estimate.

The Transportation Department recommends the award of the contract to All American Asphalt in the amount of \$1,761,383.

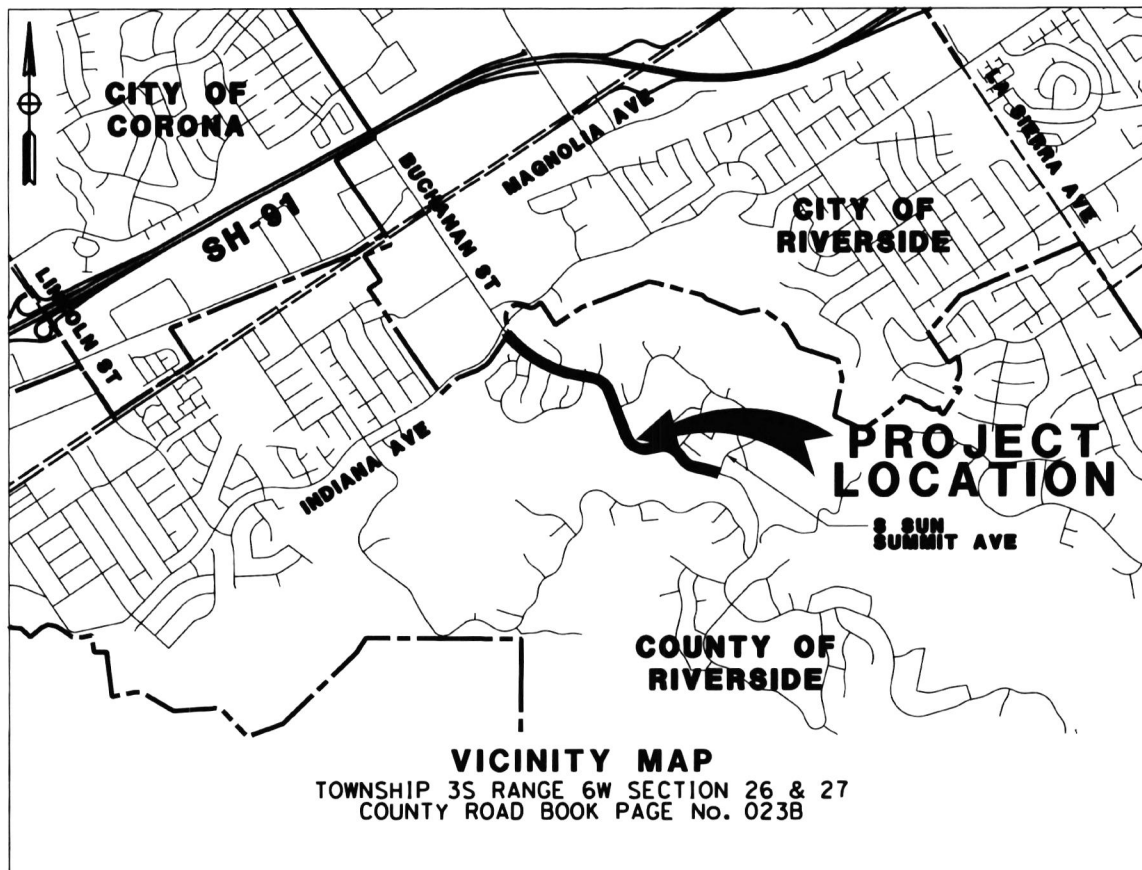
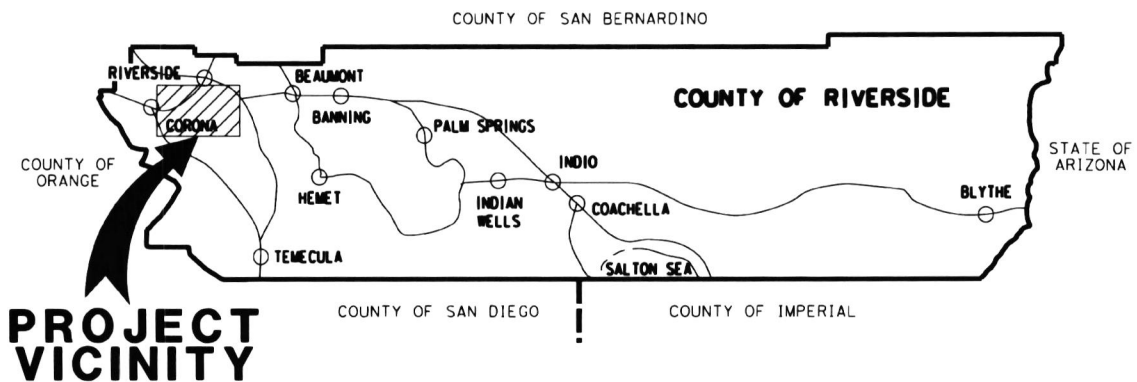

The cementitious material content of concrete must be at least 590 pounds per cubic yard for:
Cross-Gutter and Spandrels

Add to Section 73-1.02B Detectable Warning Surfaces:

73-1.02B Detectable Warning Surfaces (Truncated Domes)

This work includes installing detectable warning surfaces on the curb ramps or on the areas as shown and specified on the plans, in conformance with section 73-1.02B, Section 73-3, and Section 73-3.01D(2) of Standard Specifications, Standard Plans, these Special Provisions, and as directed by the Engineer.

The curb ramp detectable warning surface will be a rigid polymer composite/fiberglass panel set into wet concrete for new ramp construction.

The color of the detectable warning surfaces will be yellow complying with Federal Standard 595B, Color No. 33538.

The manufacturer must provide a written 5-year warranty for detectable warning surface, guaranteeing replacement when there is defect in the dome shape, color fastness, sound-on-cane acoustic quality, resilience, or attachment. The warranty period will begin upon acceptance of the contract.

Installation of curb ramp detectable warning surface must comply with the manufacturer's recommendations.

Payment:

For New/Reconstructed Ramps:

Full compensation for Detectable Warning Surfaces (Truncated Dome Panels) shall be paid per considered as included in the contract unit price paid per each for Minor Concrete (Curb Ramp), and shall include full compensation for furnishing all labor, materials, tools, equipment and incidentals for doing all work involved in installing detectable warning surface, complete in place, as shown and specified on the plans, as specified in the Standard Specifications, these Special Provisions, and as directed by the Engineer, and no additional payment will be made therefor.

73-1.03 CONSTRUCTION

Add to Section 73-1.03 Construction:

Preparation of subgrade for the concrete structures shall be done in conformance with the requirements of Section 73-1.03B Subgrade Preparation of the Standard Specifications.

Excess material resulting from the excavation of the subgrade shall be disposed of as provided in Section 00-1.14, 'Disposal of Excess Excavation Or Materials', of these Special Provisions.

Full compensation for the removal of existing minor concrete structures (Driveway Approach, Sidewalk, Curb and Gutter, Curb Ramps, and Cross-Gutter and Spandrels) shall be considered as included in the contract bid prices for such minor concrete structures.

The Contractor is responsible for meeting requirements of American with Disabilities Act (ADA), the current edition of the California Building Code, and the draft and final versions of the Accessibility Guidelines for Pedestrian Facilities within the Public Right of Way as published by the United States Access Board.

Construction of minor concrete items shall include, but not be limited to, the following:

- 1) Removal and disposal of existing Driveway Approach, Sidewalk, Curb and Gutter, Curb Ramps, and Cross-Gutter and Spandrels and existing soil and aggregate as required;

- 3) Establishing grades, and assuring that all grades are met;
