BACKGROUND:

Summary

A proposal was submitted to the Riverside Local Agency Formation Commission (LAFCO) requesting a reorganization to include annexation to the City of Moreno Valley and concurrent annexation to Moreno Valley Community Services District (subsidiary), and detachment from Valley-Wide Recreation and Park District, in an area totaling approximately 82.24 acres, located within the County of Riverside, south and east of Gilman Springs Road, east of Virginia Street, and north of Alessandro Boulevard, within the Sphere of Influence of Moreno Valley, to the Moreno Valley Community Services District for provision of parks and recreation services.

Section 99(b)(5) of the Revenue & Taxation Code sets forth that, prior to LAFCO proceeding with a public hearing to consider this proposal, an exchange of property tax revenue between agencies responsible for public services must be negotiated. Although the County is not responsible for provision of parks and recreation services in the proposed project area, and its unincorporated area jurisdiction and property tax revenue will be unaffected by this proposal, said section of Code requires that the County shall be responsible for consulting with each agency and negotiating the property tax revenue exchange on their behalf.

On various dates between February and April of 2024, representatives from the County of Riverside, the Moreno Valley Community Services District, and Valley-Wide Recreation and Park District met and ultimately agreed to terms for the exchange of property tax revenues between the two agencies; these terms are set forth in attached Board of Supervisors Resolution No. 2024-108. A similar resolution memorializing this exchange was adopted by the Valley-Wide Recreation and Park District on April 15, 2024, and a resolution for adoption by the Moreno Valley Community Services District Board can be found on their May 7, 2024 agenda.

The exchange of property tax revenues would become effective for tax purposes beginning July 1 of the subsequent year following the date of annexation. As provided for in the attached resolution, Moreno Valley Community Services District would assume service responsibility for provision of parks and recreation services within the Project area, and for such service, it would receive 100% of the post-annexation incremental property tax revenues that would have been allocated to the Valley-Wide Recreation and Park District within the Project area. The Valley-Wide Recreation and Park District would retain 100% of the base property tax revenues allocated to it in the fiscal year preceding the date of annexation within the Project area.

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Impact on Residents and Businesses

If approved by LAFCO, the proposed service boundary reorganization would result in Moreno Valley Community Services District providing parks and recreation services to the Project area, which is within the City of Moreno Valley; the Moreno Valley Community Services District currently provides parks and recreation services to all territory within the City's boundary.

Additional Fiscal Information

The County's property tax revenue will not be impacted by this proposal.

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RESOLUTION NO. 2024-108

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE DETERMINING THE AMOUNT OF PROPERTY TAX REVENUE TO BE EXCHANGED BETWEEN THE MORENO VALLEY COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT AND VALLEY-WIDE RECREATION AND PARK DISTRICT PURSUANT TO LAFCO 2023-05-5

WHEREAS, a proposal was submitted to the Riverside Local Agency Formation Commission (LAFCO) requesting a reorganization to include annexation to the City of Moreno Valley and concurrent annexation to Moreno Valley Community Services District (subsidiary), and detachment from Valley-Wide Recreation and Park District, in an area totaling approximately 82.24 acres, located within the County of Riverside, south and east of Gilman Springs Road, east of Virginia Street, and north of Alessandro Boulevard, within the Sphere of Influence of Moreno Valley, to the Moreno Valley Community Services District for provision of parks and recreation services; and,

WHEREAS, Revenue and Taxation Code Section 99(b)(5) sets forth that agencies and special districts whose service area or responsibility will be altered by a jurisdictional change must negotiate an exchange of property tax revenues, and that the County Board of Supervisors shall, after consultation with each special district, negotiate such an exchange on their behalf, and,

WHEREAS, representatives of Moreno Valley Community Services District and Valley-Wide Recreation and Park District have met individually with representatives from the County of Riverside on February 27, 2024, with various telephone and electronic message correspondence occurring thereafter, to provide comments on said negotiation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, DETERMINED AND ORDERED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside, in regular session assembled on April 30, 2024, at 9:30 am or soon thereafter in the meeting room of the Board of Supervisors located on the 1st floor of the County Administrative Center, 4080 Lemon Street, Riverside, California, as follows:

Section 1. Moreno Valley Community Services District and Valley-Wide Recreation and Park District are the agencies whose area of responsibility for service would be affected by LAFCO 2023-05-5.

Section 2. Representatives of Moreno Valley Community Services District and Valley-Wide Recreation and Park District have met individually with representatives from the County of Riverside, and negotiated the following exchange of property tax revenue to become effective as of the date of annexation for the parcels identified in LAFCO 2023-05-5:

- (a) The Valley-Wide Recreation and Park District shall retain 100 percent of the base property tax revenues allocated to it in the fiscal year immediately preceding the date of annexation within the territory to be annexed.
- (b) The Moreno Valley Community Services District shall assume responsibility for provision of all parks and recreation services in the area to be annexed, and for such service assumption, shall receive 100 percent of incremental property tax revenues that, absent this exchange of property tax revenues, would have been allocated to Valley-Wide Recreation and Park District pursuant to Section 96.5 of the Revenue and Taxation Code within the territory to be annexed in all fiscal years after the date of annexation.

Section 3. The Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside hereby agrees to the aboverecited exchange of property tax revenue.

Section 4. The County Auditor shall convert the above-established percentages into actual dollar figures and thereafter allocate such property tax revenues in accord with the provisions of Section 95 et seq. of the Revenue and Taxation Code.

Section 5. The Clerk of the Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside shall transmit a certified copy of this resolution to each affected agency, to the Executive Officer of the Riverside Local Agency Formation Commission, and to the Auditor of the County of Riverside pursuant to Section 99 of the Revenue and Taxation Code.
