## **BACKGROUND:**

Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

- 1. Habitat for Humanity International, Inc. Inland Valley \$2,000-The funds will support the Home Repair and Preservation Program, a program that assists low-income homeowners with exterior home repairs and/or maintenance at little to no cost.
- 2. **Murrieta/Wildomar Chamber of Commerce** -\$1,000- The funds will be used to support the All-Chambers Mega Mixer. This event fosters and creates economic development connections through the collaboration of partner chambers.
- 3. **Animal Friends of the Valleys** -\$1,000- Funding will be used to support the FORE Animals Golf Tournament, an event that raises funds for the caring and the spay/ neuter of shelter animals.
- 4. **Anza Civic Improvement League-**\$2,500- The funding will be used to support the Anza Days Celebration and Parade 2024.
- 5. **Green Acres Interactive Therapy** -\$10,000- The funding will be used to support the Gait Therapy Program, a program that provides equine therapy to 3<sup>rd</sup> district residents with developmental disabilities such as ADHD, cerebral palsy, autism, hearing, and sight loss.
- 6. **Friends Uniting Neighbors, Inc.**-\$10,980- The funding will be used to support the Senior Food Box program, a program that provides seniors with a food box filled with meat, dairy, and produce.
- 7. Anza Electric Cooperative, Inc. -\$5,000-The funding will be used to pay for fuel for the Find Food Bank trucks to deliver fresh food and non-perishable food supplies for a monthly food distribution to low-income residents living in Anza.
