BACKGROUND:

Summary

Riverside County Regional Park and Open-Space District (RivCoParks) manages hundreds of acres of land along the Santa Ana River Bottom (SARB). In the past few years, however, RivCoParks has increased its presence in the SARB, participating in the Homeless Solutions Collaborative working group and the County's Multi-Disciplinary Team (MDT) with the Housing Department. This project proposes to enhance RivCoParks' engagement services and habitat restoration work within the SARB by constructing a dedicated maintenance building and yard for the SARB Unit. This building will provide a dedicated space to effectively manage and maintain equipment, infrastructure, and assets. Centralized storage, easy access to tools and equipment, specialized facilities for repairs and inspections, and a controlled environment for maintenance activities, will allow SARB Unit staff to serve the community more effectively.

Construction bid documents have been reviewed by County Counsel and approved as to form.

CEQA CONSIDERATIONS

Through preparation of the Initial Study/Mitigated Negative Declaration (IS/MND), RivCoParks has determined that the project would not result in a significant environmental impact. Mitigation measures have been included in the project to avoid potentially significant effects in the following areas:

- Biological Resources
- Cultural Resources
- · Geology and Soils
- Tribal Cultural Resources

With the implementation of mitigation measures each of the potentially significant impacts would be reduced to less than significant, therefore, RivCoParks prepared a Mitigated Negative Declaration (MND) pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines section 15152. The Draft IS/MND was published on March 11, 2024 for public review, ending on April 1, 2024 (State Clearinghouse Number 2024030301).

RivCoParks now seeks adoption of the final IS/MND and the filing of the Notice of Determination (NOD) that the Project will not have significant impact on the environment. Pursuant to

Assembly Bill (AB) 52, the proposed cultural resources mitigation measures and tribal cultural resources mitigation measure were revised consistent with consultation with the tribes.

ADDITIONAL FISCAL INFORMATION

American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funds in the amount of \$5,000,000 were allocated to this project on May 23, 2023. This project is fully funded by the Second District's ARPA allocation. However, due to revised supervisorial district boundary limits that will be implemented in January 2025, the project will be located in the First District at that point in time.

WHEREAS, the Riverside County Regional Park & Open-Space District ("Park District") is the lead agency in the development of the Santa Ana River Bottom Maintenance Facility Project ("Project") within Riverside County and has allocated American Recovery Plan Act ("ARPA") funds from the County of Riverside to develop and construct the Project; and,

WHEREAS, the Park District, acting as the public agency carrying out the actual Project, served as the lead agency for the environmental review, analysis, and approval of the construction and operation of the Project pursuant to the requirements of CEQA (See State CEQA Guidelines section 15051(a)); and,

WHEREAS, the Park District, as lead agency, prepared an Initial Study ("IS") to assess the potential environmental impacts associated with the proposed Project, which was released on March 11, 2024, for a 20-day public review, ending on April 1, 2024 (State Clearinghouse Number 2024030301); and

WHEREAS, all requirements of CEQA have been met and the Park District has determined that with mitigation, the Project will not have a significant adverse effect upon the environment and a Mitigated Negative Declaration ("MND") was prepared; and

WHEREAS, the IS/MND (SCH No. 2024030301) thoroughly addresses the environmental effects of implementing the Project, including the construction and maintenance of the various improvements identified therein; and

WHEREAS, all of the findings and conclusions made by the Board of Directors pursuant to this resolution are based upon the oral and written evidence presented to it as a whole and not based solely on the information provided in this resolution; and

WHEREAS, all procedures of CEQA have been met and all other legal prerequisites to the adoption of this Resolution have occurred.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, DETERMINED AND ORDERED THAT the Board of Directors of the Riverside County Regional Park and Open-Space District assembled in regular session on June 4, 2024, in the meeting room of the Board of Directors located on the 1st floor of the County Administrative Center, 4080 Lemon Street, Riverside, California, at or after 9:00 a.m., based upon the evidence and testimony presented on the matter, both written and oral, including the Initial Study and the Mitigated Negative Declaration, as it relates to the Project, does hereby make the following findings and determinations:

SECTION 1. Incorporation of Recitals. The above recitations constitute findings of the Board of Directors are incorporated herein.

SECTION 2. CEQA Actions

(a) Consideration of the Mitigated Negative Declaration and Adoption of Findings Regarding CEQA Compliance. As the decision-making body for Park District, and in Park District's role as lead agency under CEQA, the Board of Directors has received, reviewed, and considered the information contained in the Initial Study and Mitigated Negative Declaration for the Santa Ana River Bottom Maintenance Facility Project, all comment letters, and other related documents. Based on this review, the Board of Directors finds that based upon the entire record before it, that there is no substantial evidence that the Project will have a significant effect on the environment. The Board of Directors also finds that the Initial Study and Mitigated Negative Declaration for the Project contains a complete, objective, and accurate reporting of those potential impacts and this determination reflects the independent judgment and analysis of the Park District, as well as the Board of Directors.

(b) Adoption of Mitigation Monitoring and Reporting Program. The Board of Directors hereby approves and adopts the Mitigation Monitoring and Reporting Program, which was prepared for the Project and is attached within the Initial Study/Mitigated Negative Declaration.

SECTION 3. Adoption of Mitigated Negative Declaration and Approval of the Project. As required by State CEQA Guidelines section 15074 and in its role as lead agency under CEQA, the Board of Directors hereby Adopts the Mitigated Negative Declaration and approves the Project.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, DETERMIEND AND ORDERED that the Board of Directors hereby direct staff to file a Notice of Determination with the Riverside County Clerk and also with the Governor's Office of Planning and Research within five (5) working days of the approval of the Project.
