BACKGROUND:

Summary

On July 15, 2014, Item 9-4, the Board of Supervisors approved a revision to Ordinance 640, Department of Environmental Health (DEH) Service Fees. DEH has submitted its Fiscal Year 24/25 recommended budget to the Executive Office. The budget represents increases in employee salaries/benefits, an overall increase to ISF rates, and private commercial lease costs. The department has completed a cost study in accordance with Board of Supervisor's Policy B-4, *Rates Charged for Current Services*, to support the FY24/25 recommended budget.

DEH last raised fees in FY 22/23 by 4%; but not the full CPI of 8.6%. However, those increases were not universal amongst every program category and were limited to 4% due to continued challenging economic conditions related to COVID-19 and balancing increased departmental operating costs. Additionally, DEH did not increase its fees for FY 23/24 and absorbed increased costs.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

The proposed revised Environmental Health Service fees are necessary for the on-going operational costs to ensure effective and efficient delivery of environmental health programs for the benefit of Riverside County residents and businesses.

Additional Fiscal Information

DEH established a cost model to support its FY24/25 fees. The cost model allows the department to measure the level of effort of providing services, allocate indirect costs on an equitable basis, and ensure fees are fairly charged. The cost model also ensures passthrough revenues are properly applied to offset the department's operating costs.

As required by Ordinance 640, DEH certifies that (1) the updated required fees produce sufficient revenue to support the proposed costs of providing the services in the upcoming fiscal year for which required fees are being charged and (2) the new required fees will not produce revenue that exceeds the proposed costs of providing the services in the upcoming fiscal year for which the new required fees are charged. Due to increased operating costs, DEH is requesting an average fee adjustment of 3.0% but no more than 6.0% to categories shown in Attachment A. For reference, prior adopted rates and proposed rates with dollar increase are shown in Attachment B.
