

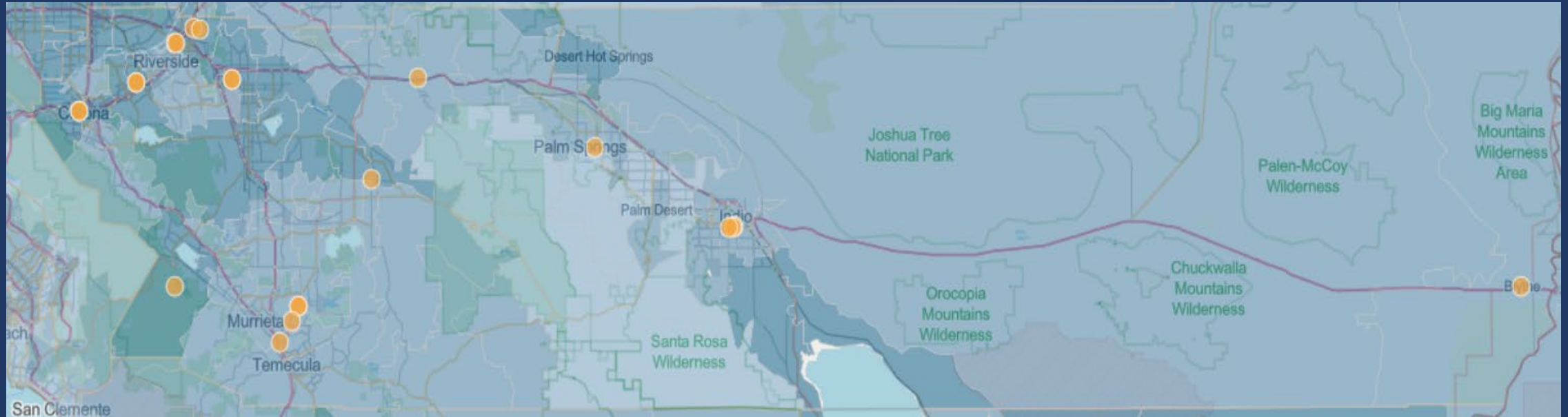

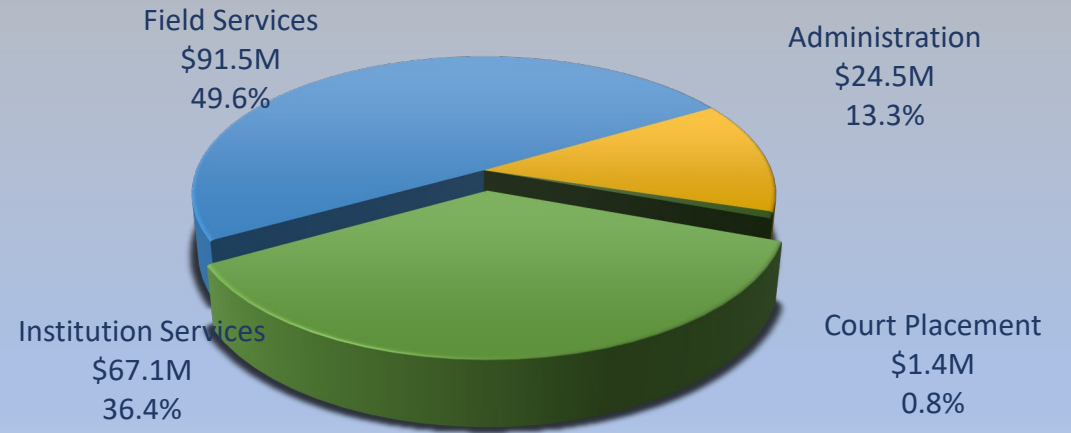

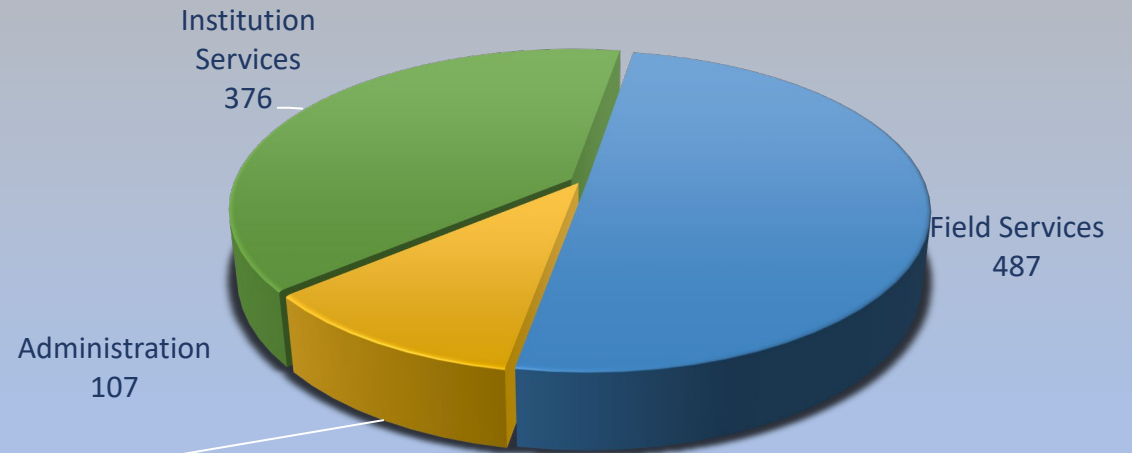

## Budget Allocation

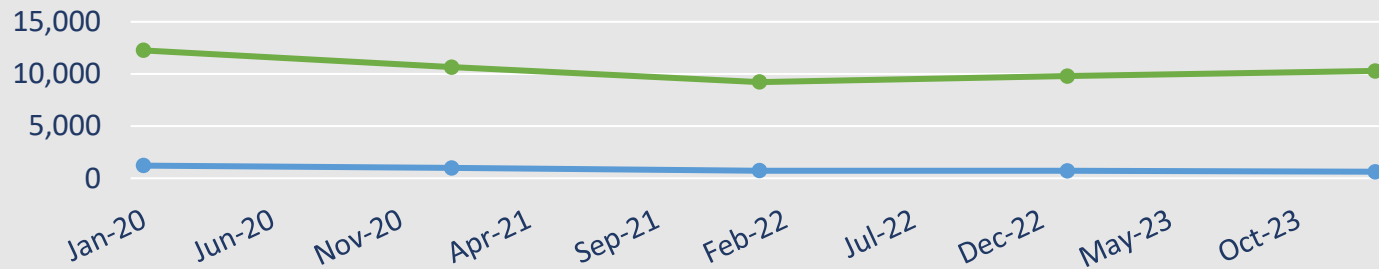


## Authorized Staffing Allocation



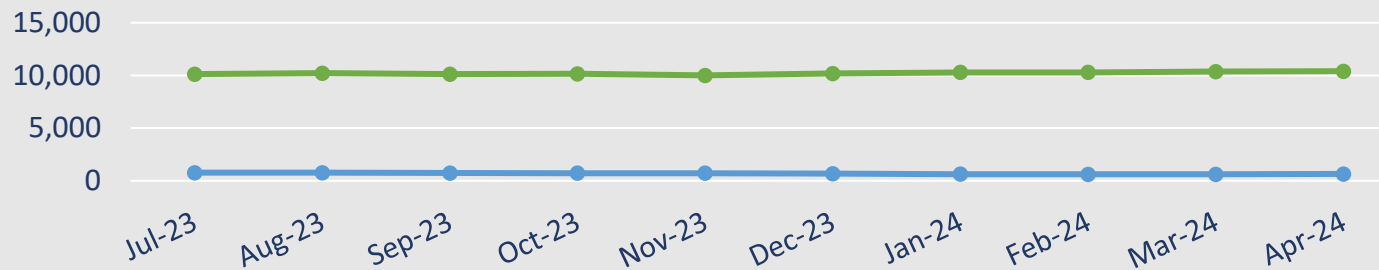

Active Clients by Month - CY

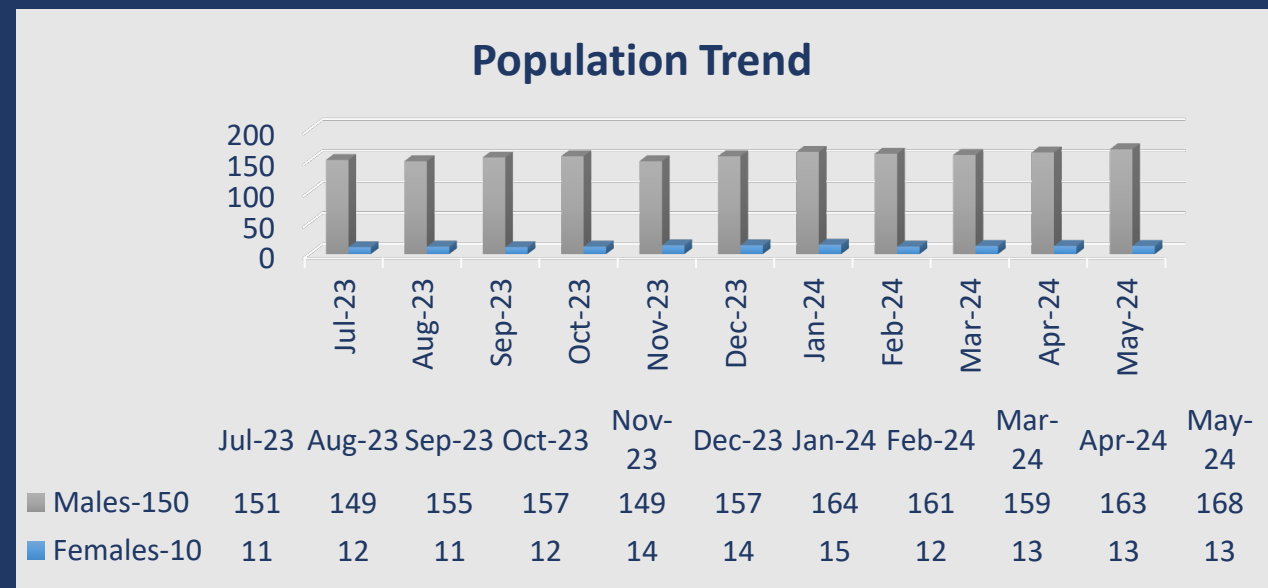
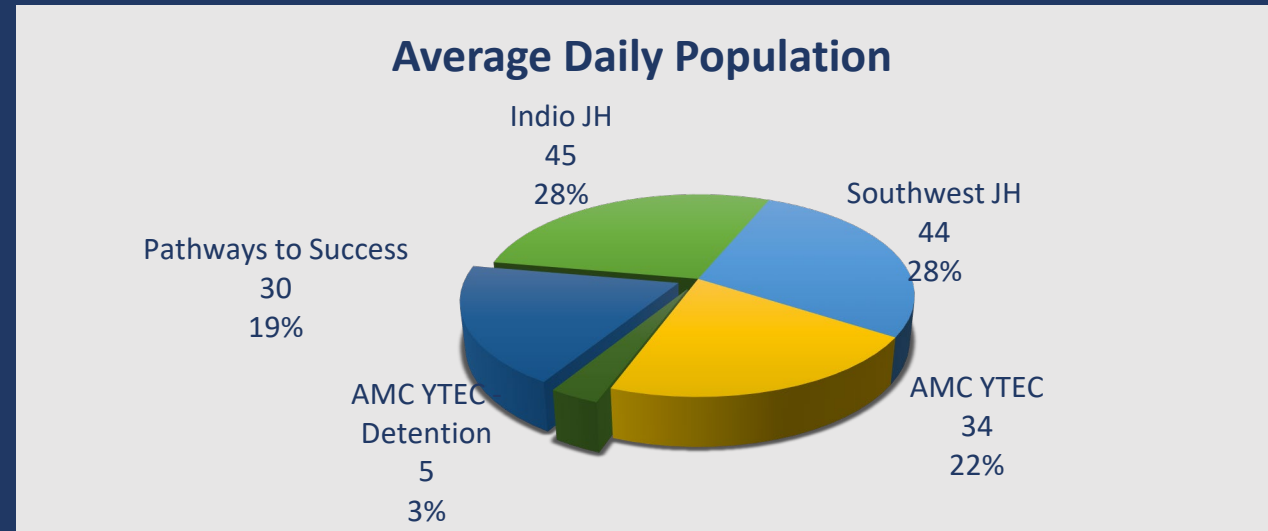

# INSTITUTION SERVICES

- ◆ Section § 1321 of Title 15 requires:
  - ◆ An adequate number of personnel sufficient to carry out the overall facility operation and its programming
  - ◆ Provide for safety and security of youth and staff
  - ◆ Meet established standards and regulations; and
  - ◆ Ensure that no required services shall be denied because of insufficient numbers of staff on duty absent exigent circumstances.
  
- ◆ SB823 changed the age of juvenile jurisdiction. It spans between 12 and 25 years of age.



# Provide for Safety and Security of Youth and Staff in Our Juvenile Facilities

- Comprehensive Training
  - Increased training for staff assigned to Institutions
- Regular Inspections
  - Passed BSCC Inspections
- Secure Perimeter
  - Increased the height of fencing at AMC - YTEC
  - Secured Walkway - SJH
- Safety and Surveillance Systems
  - Camera Projects - IJH
  - Full Body Scanner

# NEXT STEPS:

- Enhance medical care within our facilities
  - Monitor for changes in vital signs due to:
    - History of Alcohol & Drug Use
    - Suicide Attempts
    - Lack of medical care in the community
- Recent Critical Incidents
  - July 2021 – Indio Juvenile Hall
  - April 2022 – Southwest Juvenile Hall
  - July 2023 – Southwest Juvenile Hall

## FY24/25 NCC REQUEST DECISION PACKAGES

- Fund a Pilot Program at Southwest Juvenile Hall.
  - Utilize the Custody Protect system on all in-custody youth at the facility (Approximately 50)
  - Work with Correctional Health Staff to set up the Standard Operating Procedures

- NCC REQUEST:
