## BACKGROUND:

Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

- Oak Grove Institute Foundation, Inc. \$1,500-The funds will be used to support the Rock the Oaks event, an event that raises funds for the Arts and Autism programs at the Oak Grove Center.
- 2. **5&2 Compassionate Ministry** -\$9,399- The funds will be used to support the 5&2 program, a program that provides families in need in the Wildomar, Murrieta, and Menifee areas with an emergency food box that contains at least 7 meals per household.
- 3. Community First Church of God -\$9,399- Funding will be used to support the Homeland Community pantry. This pantry specifically caters to the senior population in the Homeland, Sun City, Romoland, Winchester, Anza, and Menifee areas.
- 4. Menifee Valley Community Cupboard-\$9,399- The funding will be used to support two programs: (1) the community cupboard with the purchase of pantry staples and (2) the Celebrity Karaoke, an event that raises funds to support the Cupboard Mobile Food Pantry, a program that delivers meals to Quail valley and Romoland residents.
- 5. Murrieta-Temecula Area Alumnae Chapter, Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc.-\$720- The funds will be used to support the 4<sup>th</sup> Annual September Breakfast fundraiser, an event that raises money to support the organization's youth mental health and social action programs.
