BACKGROUND:

<u>Summary</u>

The District Attorney's Office has a need for three (3) new vehicles and has secured alternative funding for the purchase. One (1) of these vehicles is to be outfitted to accommodate a Canine/K-9 Unit, which is critical for the support of victims and witnesses. The Division of Victim Services K-9 Facility Dog Program features specially trained facility dogs, that provide support services countywide to vulnerable children and adults while they testify in court; it also augments the Crime Prevention Unit (CPU) services by providing support to clients on an as-needed basis. These canines serve a critical role in rapport building with youths receiving CPU services and/or attending CPU programs; additionally, they offer canine support in needs assessment interviews, groups/presentations, and counseling/case management sessions. Juvenile Justice Crime Prevention Act (JJCPA) grant funds will be used to procure the vehicle (\$50,522). This vehicle has been previously approved as part of FY 2023/24 budget and this cash purchase will expedite the procurement process.

Two (2) of these vehicles are to support the functions of the Real Estate Fraud (REF) Unit. The purpose of the vehicles requested for REF is to allow our Investigators and Investigative Technicians to conduct daily activities required by their REF assignments. These activities include, but are not limited to, conducting interviews, collection of evidence or documents, search warrant execution, surveillance, and serving subpoenas.

Real Estate Fraud sub funds will be used to procure the vehicles (\$73,010).

Impact on Residents and Businesses

The purchase is funded 100% JJCPA Grant administered through Riverside County Probation Department as well as the District Attorney REF sub fund, therefore there is no additional impact on the General Fund.
