BACKGROUND:

Summary

The State of California Department of California Highway Patrol (CHP) is responsible for traffic enforcement on County maintained roadways within the unincorporated areas in Riverside County. At times it is desired to have dedicated CHP presence during certain activities that may have a higher risk to workers or the traveling public during construction activities such as construction of County Transportation Improvement (TIP) Projects or construction related to maintenance of such roads.

When it is identified that dedicated CHP presence during some activities would improve safety for all, a Reimbursable Letter of Agreement between the County and CHP is required. This agreement sets forth the terms and costs for the overtime services to be provided by CHP and reimbursed by the County. Section 7 of this agreement requires that:

"When one of the contracting parties is a county, city, district, or other local public body, this Agreement shall be accompanied by a copy of the resolution, order, motion, or ordinance of the local governing body, which by law provides the authority to enter into and execution of this Agreement. When performance by the local government entity will be completed before any payment by the CHP, such as a room rental or a one-time event, a resolution is not required."

Impact on Residents and Businesses

The coordination with CHP will improve the safety of staff, construction workers, and the traveling public.
