BACKGROUND:

Summary

Judges in Superior Courts may make motions directing the county to pay for creating a verbatim record in criminal matters, appeals, juvenile proceedings, proceedings to declare a minor free from custody, probate proceedings and some civil matters. The adopted budget for these fees paid to court reporters was based on the prior three-year average. However, trials have steadily increased as the Courts ramp back-up to pre-pandemic workloads resulting in increased costs to this budget unit. A shortage of court reporters has also driven up the cost of transcripts driving expenditures to unprecedented levels — even making the \$350,000 Budget Adjustment just made in February 2024 insufficient to cover newly projected costs. Current projections reflect the need for an additional \$375,000 in appropriation to meet demands for Fiscal Year 2023-24.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

Providing these services allows the County to support attorneys to help meet their constitutionally mandated requirement to deliver an adequate defense.

Additional Fiscal Information

The Executive Office requests \$375,000 from general fund contingency for the current fiscal year as there are not sufficient departmental funds for projected expenditures in Fiscal Year 2023-24.
