SUBJECT: RIVERSIDE UNIVERSITY HEALTH SYSTEM – PUBLIC HEALTH: Authorize Acceptance of the Notice of Award No. CDC-RFA-DP-23-0005 from the California Department of Public Health (CDPH) for the Cardiovascular Health (CVH) Innovation Program for the Period of Performance July 1, 2024 through June 30, 2028, and Amend Salary Ordinance No. 440 Pursuant to Resolution No. 440-9429 Submitted Herewith. All Districts [Total aggregate amount: \$3,915,330; up to \$783,066 in additional funding -- 100% Federal]

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Authorize the acceptance of the Notice of Award No. CDC-RFA-DP-23-0005 from the California Department of Public Health (CDPH) for the Cardiovascular Health (CVH) Innovation Program for the period of performance July 1, 2024 through June 30, 2028;
2. Amend Salary Ordinance No. 440 pursuant to Resolution No.440-9429 submitted herewith; and
3. Authorize the Director of Public Health, or designee, based on the availability of fiscal funding and approved as to form by County Counsel, to: (a) sign all certifications, assurances, or reports to implement the Award and the Grant Agreement including, but not limited to, signing the Grant Agreement; and (b) signing subsequent amendments that do not exceed the sum total of twenty percent (20%) of the total aggregate amount of the Award.

BACKGROUND:

Summary

On Behalf of the California Department of Public Health (CDPH), the Cardiovascular Health (CVH) Innovation Program is awarding Riverside University Health System – Public Health (RUHS-PH) with funding from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention. RUHS-PH’s Nutrition and Health Promotion Branch will support efforts and partner with CDPH chronic disease prevention programs and stakeholders to implement health equity solutions. The programs will focus on improving the health and quality of life among priority populations diagnosed with cardiovascular disease, hypertension, high blood, and cholesterol.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

Riverside County is the 4th largest county in California and the 10th largest in the US with 7,303 square miles representing health disparities and inequities. The programs will target populations in need of healthcare and social services within Riverside County. Duties include collaborating with partners to connect non-clinical teams with patients diagnosed with Hypertension (HTN), High Blood Cholesterol (HBC), Cardiovascular Disease (CVD), conducting educational webinars, developing innovative practices for addressing health disparities, and increasing access to HTN/HBC/CVD resources (e.g., for self-measured blood pressure (SMBP) and other resources such as video modules to reach Riverside County communities with a hypertension prevalence of 53% or higher at the census tract level.

Additional Fiscal Information

RUHS-PH will receive 100% of this funding from the State of California as a pass through from the Federal government. There is no impact to County General Funds. The table below outlines how the funds will be distributed over the period of the agreement and the funding allocation for the county budget fiscal years. RUHS-PH is requesting approval from the Board to accept the aggregate amount in order to allow funds to rollover from one fiscal year to the next, as well as approval to accept additional funding from CDPH, not to exceed 20% of the total aggregate award amount.
