BACKGROUND:

<u>Summary</u>

The County of Riverside Transportation Department (County) is proposing to replace six (6) timber bridges: two in the Cabazon area, and four in the Desert Center area. These bridges were built in the early 1930s. Each being older than 80 years, they have completed their useful service life and exhibit various structural and hydraulic deficiencies.

On October 23, 2018, Agenda Item 3.29, the County Board of Supervisors executed an Engineering and Environmental Services Agreement for the Replacement of Six Timber Bridges on Chuckwalla Valley Road and Railroad Avenue (Bridge No. 56C0099, 56C0101, 56C0102, 56C0103, 56C0104, 56C0108) with CNS Engineers, Inc. to complete all phases of the project: (I) Preliminary Engineering/Environmental Clearance/Technical Report, (II) Plans, Specifications and Estimates (PS&E), (III) Construction Bidding and Award Support, and (IV) Design Support During Construction.

The County is the lead agency for the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), and based on delegation by the Federal Highway Administration, the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) is the lead agency for the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA).

The environmental technical studies revealed that Railroad Avenue and Chuckwalla Valley Road were part of historic highways, potentially eligible for listing in historic registers and the California Register of Historical Resources. As a result, additional evaluation and coordination are necessary, leading to further coordination and services in terms of obtaining project approval from Caltrans and other regulatory agencies.

Amendment No.1 is being processed to extend the time period of the Agreement to assess the additional scope of services, schedule, and budget needed to perform these additional services. Additional costs for performing these services will be assessed and compiled to compensate the consultant through a second amendment at a later date.

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AMENDMENT NO. 1

TO THE ENGINEERING AND ENVIRONMENTAL SERVICES AGREEMENT FOR REPLACEMENT OF SIX

TIMBER BRIDGES ON CHUCKWALLA VALLEY ROAD AND RAILROAD AVENUE (BRIDGE NO.

56C0099, 56C0101, 56C0102, 56C0103, 56C0104, 56C0108) BETWEEN COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE •

TRANSPORTATION DEPARTMENT AND CNS ENGINEERS, INC.

RECITALS

- A. COUNTY and ENGINEER have entered into an agreement entitled "Engineering and Environmental Services Agreement for Replacement of Six Timber Bridges on Chuckwalla Valley Road and Railroad Avenue (Bridge No. 56C0099, 56C0101, 56C0102, 56C0103, 56C0104, 56C0108) between County of Riverside Transportation Department and CNS Engineers, Inc." that is dated October 23, 2018, Agenda Item 3.29 (hereinafter the "AGREEMENT"). The AGREEMENT provides the terms and conditions, scope of work, schedule, and budget for the performance of professional and technical services related to all phases of the PROJECT: (I) Preliminary Engineering/Environmental Clearance/Technical Report, (II) Plans, Specifications and Estimates (PS&E), (III) Construction Bidding and Award Support, and (IV) Design Support During Construction for the replacement of Six Timber Bridges on Chuckwalla Valley Road and Railroad Avenue (Bridge No. 56C0099, 56C0101, 56C0102, 56C0103, 56C0104, 56C0108) (hereinafter the "PROJECT").
- B. The PROJECT environmental technical studies revealed that the Railroad Ave and Chuckwalla Valley Road were part of historic highways, potentially eligible for listing in National Register of Historic Places and California Register of Historical Resources. As a result, further evaluation and coordination is necessary, leading to additional PROJECT coordination and services in terms of obtaining PROJECT

Replacement of Six Timber Bridges on Chuckwalla Valley Road and Railroad Avenue approval from the California Department of Transportation (hereinafter "CALTRANS") and other regulatory agencies.

- C. Appendix B Article BI• Introduction of the AGREEMENT establishes the time period for performing the scope of services detailed in Appendix A of the AGREEMENT. The terms and conditions specify that all covenants set forth in the AGREEMENT shall be completed by June 30, 2024, unless extended by supplemental agreement.
- D. Amendment No. 1 is needed to extend the schedule of services of the AGREEMENT to complete the scope of services set forth in the AGREEMENT.
- E. The parties agree to amend the AGREEMENT to extend the time period for performing the scope of services.

AGREEMENT

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants hereinafter contained, the parties agree as follows:

- 1. The last sentence of the first paragraph of Appendix B Article BI• Introduction of the AGREEMENT is amended to revise the completion date from June 30, 2024, to June 30, 2029, as follows: "All covenants set forth in this AGREEMENT shall be completed by June 30, 2029, unless extended by supplemental agreement."
- Except to the extent specifically modified or amended hereunder, all the terms, covenants and conditions of the AGREEMENT shall remain in full force and effect between the parties hereto.
- This Amendment No. 1 shall become effective upon signature of this Amendment No. 1 by both parties or July 1, 2024, whichever should come first.
- 4. This Amendment No. 1 may be executed in any number of counterparts, each of which shall be an original, but all of which together shall constitute one and the same instrument. Each party to this Amendment No. 1 agrees to the use of electronic signatures, such as digital signatures that meet the requirements of the California Uniform Electronic Transactions Act (("CUETA") Cal. Civ. Code §§ 1633.1 to 1633.17), for executing this Amendment No. 1. The parties further agree that the electronic signatures of the parties included in this Amendment No. 1 are intended to authenticate this writing and to have the

Replacement of Six Timber Bridges on Chuckwalla Valley Road and Railroad Avenue same force and effect as manual signatures. Electronic signature means an electronic sound, symbol, or process attached to or logically associated with an electronic record and executed or adopted by a person with the intent to sign the electronic record pursuant to the CUETA as amended from time to time. The CUETA authorizes use of an electronic signature for transactions and contracts among parties in California, including a government agency. Digital signature means an electronic identifier, created by computer, intended by the party using it to have the same force and effect as the use of a manual signature, and shall be reasonably relied upon by the parties. For purposes of this section, a digital signature is a type of "electronic signature" as defined in subdivision (i) of Section 1633.2 of the Civil Code.


