BACKGROUND:

Summary

The Classification and Compensation (C&C) division received a request from the Office of the District Attorney (DA) to perform a market study on the *District Attorney Hazardous Waste Examiner* classification. The study was requested because the DA wants to ensure that this classification remains competitive based on current market data and support their ongoing recruitment and retention efforts.

The market survey (Attachment #2) revealed that this classification is below market at the minimum rate by 2.72% and below market at the maximum rate by 9.90%. C&C recommends adjusting the *District Attorney Hazardous Waste Examiner* to the following salary range to ensure our recruiting and retention practices are competitive.

Salary Adjustments:

District Attorney Hazardous Waste Examiner: It is recommended to adjust the salary plan/grade SEU 676 (\$82,206 - \$106,586) to salary plan/grade SEU 706 (\$84,500 - \$118,300). There are currently 0 incumbents in this classification.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

Approval of this recommendation will have no direct impact to residents or businesses.

Additional Fiscal Information:

There are currently no incumbents in this classification, therefore no cost is incurred. However, the estimated cost to fund one District Attorney Hazardous Waste Examiner is approximately \$171,535 which includes benefits.
