BACKGROUND:

Summary 5 1 1

Each year the Riverside County Flood Control and Water Conservation District ("District") budgets the estimated cost of construction projects. For FY23/24, the District underestimated the cost of ongoing construction projects within the Zone 3 Const/Maint/Misc Fund ("Fund 25130"). As a result, the District is requesting a budget adjustment to increase the Fixed Assets and Professional Services appropriations in Fund 25130 to facilitate payment of services rendered in FY23/24 under the active construction contracts. These increases in appropriations will be offset using the Fund 25130 unrestricted (committed) fund balance. Sufficient appropriations have been established for construction projects expected to be completed in the next fiscal year (FY24/25).

Impact on Residents and Businesses

The budget adjustment imposes no new fees, taxes or bonded indebtedness upon existing residents or business.
