3. Direct the Executive Office to work with Board offices and County departments to take the necessary steps to hold the event.



**SUBMITTAL TO THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE,

BACKGROUND:

Riverside County, home to nearly 2.5 million people, is the fourth largest county in California and the tenth largest in the United States by population. Our diverse and dynamic community deserves a clear and comprehensive update on the County's current state. The "State of the County" is an event where County leadership communicates vital information regarding the County's progress, successes, and future plans. This address is an essential platform for transparency, accountability, and community engagement.

Given the importance of the State of the County address, it is recommended that we schedule this event on October 24, 2024. This is a date that has been confirmed with a venue in Southwest Riverside County and provides sufficient time to prepare a comprehensive and meaningful presentation. A budget not-to-exceed \$75,000 is being requested for the costs of the event, which will be reduced by potential opportunities to lower costs through sponsorships or funding contributions. (This amount is the same amount that was approved for the last State of the County in 2022.)
