BACKGROUND:

Summary

The Riverside County Gang Impact Team (GIT) led by the District Attorney's Office needs to replace four (4) vehicles within its fleet. The mission of the GIT team is to make a direct impact on the public safety of Riverside County communities through the use of typical and unconventional law enforcement strategies and tactics to proactively address violent and firearm-related crimes and quality of life issues. GIT targets their investigations towards the apprehension and convictions of criminal street gang members and violent offenders through well-coordinated enforcement efforts and resources.

All four (4) vehicles which are designated to be replaced are currently more than 100,000 miles and rapidly approaching the Fleet recommended age for replacement. District Attorney vehicles that are over the 7-year Fleet recommended age are no longer covered under the maintenance agreement, resulting in direct department billing for each service instance, which in turn increases departmental spending. Retaining aged and high-mileage vehicles is therefore not cost effective to the department and also poses a safety concern for Public Safety County employees.

The four (4) vehicles are to support the functions of the Gang Impact Team (GIT). Working in conjunction with various participating agencies, GIT operates not only throughout Riverside County but the entire Southern California region.

The District Attorney's Asset Forfeiture sub funds will be used to procure the vehicles. Therefore, there will be no fiscal impact to the County's General Fund

Impact on Residents and Businesses

The purchase is funded 100% through the District Attorney Asset Forfeiture sub fund, therefore there is no additional impact on the General Fund.
