BACKGROUND:

Summary

The Public Defenders Office had an increase in salaries and benefits due to MOU increases and Union Negotiations. The Public Defenders Office is requesting general fund support to cover the cost of these increases.

The Riverside County Deputy District Attorneys Association (RCDDAA) representing approximately 249 attorneys in the offices of the District Attorney, County Counsel, Child Support Services, and Public Defender, negotiated salary and benefit increases, in order to better retain and recruit attorney staff. On July 18, 2023, the Board of Supervisors approved the salary range for all attorney classifications shall be increased by 12%, effective July 27, 2023.

As a result of the approval of the 12% salary and benefit increase, the Public Defender's FY2023/24 budget has been heavily impacted, resulting in a shortfall.

The Public Defenders Office will continue to work to identify budgetary issues and remediate them in a timely way to assure adequate appropriations are in place for successful fiscal year closure.
