BACKGROUND: Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

- Riverside University Health System Foundation \$8,500 will be used to fund critical work at RUHS Pediatrics, Neonatal Intensive Care Unit, Pediatric Intensive Care Unit, and the Child Abuse and Neglect Unit.
- 2. Voices for Children- \$10,000 will be used to support the efforts with the Court Appointed Special Advocates (CASAs) program. VFC will provide children with a CASA who will advocate for their education, vocational, physical, and mental health, housing stability, and other needs.
- 3. Hospice of the Valleys SC, Inc. \$2,500 funds will be used to offset the cost of hospice support for underinsured and uninsured patients of the 1st District. Specifically, the funds will be used to help cover the costs of unreimbursed supplies and equipment, community education and bereavement costs not otherwise covered by insurance.
- 4. Rotary Club of Riverside \$2,000 funds will be used to assist the Rotary's efforts to send high school students to the Rotary Youth Leadership Awards (RYLA), which is a three-day Leadership Conference to help further develop their leadership skills and "Service Above Self" concepts to motivate and make a positive impact in their community.
- **5.** Riverside Area Rape Crisis Center- \$2,500 funding will be used to sponsor the 43rd Annual Auction & Gala. The funds raised at this event will go to additional life-saving services free of charge to victims, survivors, and their families.
- **6. Mission Inn Foundation \$1,000** funding will be used to support the Mission Inn Run which helps preserve the legacy of the historic Riverside area, and many of the Foundation's diverse programs offered to members of the community.
