BACKGROUND:

Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

- 1. **Assistance League of Hemacinto** \$3,000- The funds will be used to support the Operation School Bell program, a program that provides new clothing to students in kindergarten through 5th grade.
- 2. **Pearl Center for Creative Arts** -\$1,500- This allocation will support the Lace and Locomotives: Spooky Steampunk Tea, an event that fosters community engagement and supports local artisans.
- 3. Boys & Girls Club of Menifee Valley-\$2,500- The funding will support the club's enrichment programs such as Character & Leadership Development, Education

- & Career Development, Health & Life Skills, The Arts, and Sports, Fitness, and Recreation.
- 4. Riverside County Deputy Sheriff Relief Foundation-\$3,000- The funding will be used to support the families of law enforcement and public safety officers who have been killed or injured in the line of duty.
- 5. **Green Acres Interactive Therapy** -\$3,000- The allocated funds will be used to provide physical and emotional therapy to individuals with developmental disabilities such as ADHD, cerebral palsy, autism, and hearing and sight loss.
- 6. **Menifee Interfaith and Community Service Council** -\$2,500- The allocated funds will be used to provide free Thanksgiving dinner to seniors and veterans on Thanksgiving Day.
- 7. Menifee Valley Chamber of Commerce-\$2,000- This allocation will support the Menifee State of the City Address. An event that brings civic leaders, residents, and businesses together to highlight the city's achievements and the future of the City of Menifee.
- 8. Friends of Valley-Wide Foundation- \$1,500- The funds will be used to support the Youth Scholarship Program, a program that provides low-income families with access to youth sports and activities at a reduced or no cost.
- Riverside University Health System Foundation-\$8,500- The allocated funds will be used to support the Festival of Trees, an event that raises funds for the Pediatric Intensive Care Unit at RUHS Medical Center.
