

BACKGROUND:

Summary

The County of Riverside (County) is proposing to construct a pedestrian bridge that will cross a gap along Skyview Road where there is no road crossing at French Valley Channel in the Community of French Valley. The proposed pedestrian bridge will provide a path between the French Valley Library, located on the northwest side of the bridge, and the Susan La Vorgna Elementary School, located at the southeast corner of the intersection of Skyview Road and Via Santiago/Algarve Avenue. It will provide multipurpose access for pedestrians and bicyclists, with no vehicular travel other than access for emergency vehicles.

The proposed pedestrian bridge will consist of a 16-foot-wide walkway and is approximately 370 feet long. The bridge will consist of 4 spans and 3 single column piers and is designed in such a way that minimizes permanent impacts to the channel, both during and after construction. Elements of the aesthetic treatments on the bridge will complement key aesthetic features of the recently completed French Valley Library.

The bid documents include the following bid schedules of work:

- Base Bid: Skyview Pedestrian Road Bridge over French Valley Channel Project
- Alternative Bid 1: Eastern Municipal Water District, Water Line Relocation

The offset and relocation of an existing 18" water pipeline is included in the bid package as an alternate bid schedule on behalf of and at the request of the Eastern Municipal Water District (EMWD). If EMWD approves the award of the alternate bid schedule as bid by the apparent low bidder, the cost for this work will be funded by EMWD.

The Transportation Department will select the contractor based upon the lowest responsive and responsible bid of the sum of all bid schedules.

The submitted plans and specifications have been approved as to form by County Counsel.

Environmental Findings

The County is the lead agency for the approval of the CEQA document for the project. By Minute Order dated September 12, 2023 (Agenda Item 3.31), the County of Riverside Board of Supervisors adopted the Initial Study/Mitigated Negative Declaration for the Skyview Pedestrian Road Bridge over French Valley Channel Project. The Notice of Determination was posted with the Riverside County Recorder's Office on September 12, 2023.

Based on study findings, the County has determined that the proposed Project will not have any potentially significant impacts on the environment through the incorporation of avoidance and minimization measures.

The adoption of the Final IS/MND and the Mitigation Monitoring and Reporting Program (MMRP) for the Project completes the CEQA environmental documentation for the project.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

The Skyview Road Pedestrian Bridge project is designed in accordance with the latest state of the art design criteria, including current seismic design standards and protection for a 100-year storm event. The proposed bridge project will provide a connection for pedestrians and bicyclists on Skyview Road across the French Valley Channel, where no connection currently exists and provide a trail path between the French Valley Library and the Susan La Vorgna Elementary school.

The work is anticipated to begin in early 2025 and will take approximately fourteen months to complete.

SUPPLEMENTAL:

Additional Fiscal Information

The construction contract is estimated to cost approximately \$5,624,847. Construction is anticipated to begin during Fiscal Year 2024/2025 and will be funded entirely using local funds, consisting of the Unincorporated Communities Initiative Fund, Gas Tax/HUTA, and Eastern Municipal Water District funds.

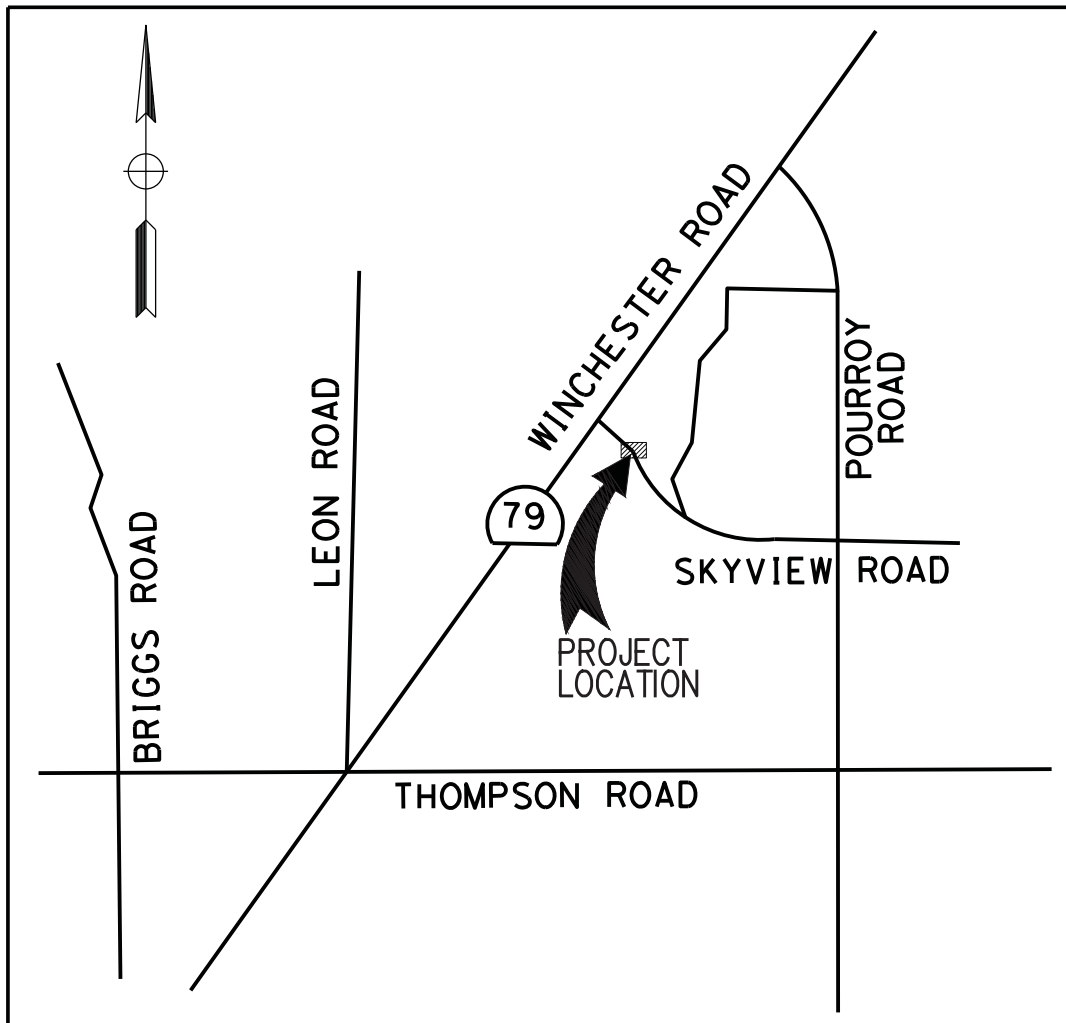
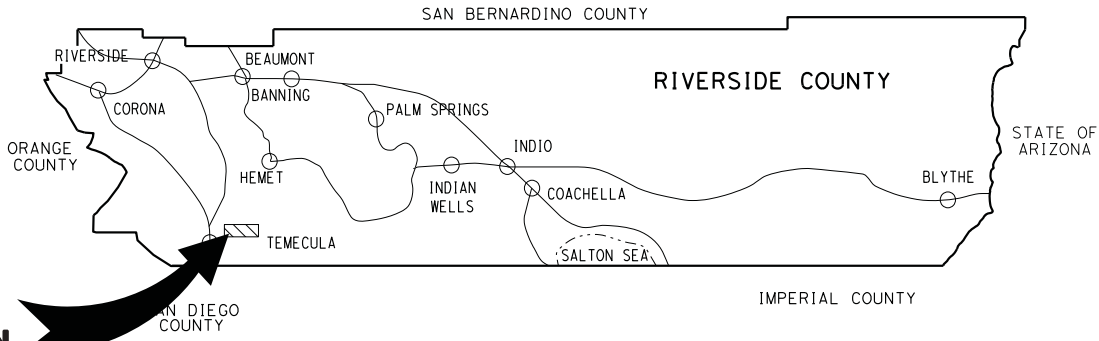
Vicinity Map
