#### **BACKGROUND:**

#### Summary

On July 18, 2023, Agenda Item 3.29 with companion Item 13.1, the Board of Supervisors approved an Agreement between the Riverside County Transportation Department (COUNTY) and the Riverside County Regional Park and Open-Space District (DISTRICT) for the design, bidding, administration, and construction of road improvements on four (4) Parks campground sites. One of the sites is Rancho Jurupa Park where the COUNTY proposes to resurface approximately 1.7 acres of parking lot and paving a combined length of approximately 5,400-feet of campground access roads within the Rancho Jurupa Regional Park in Western Riverside County. The DISTRICT will provide 100% of the project funding and will be responsible for the maintenance of the facility.

Parking lot resurfacing is needed due to the deteriorated pavement conditions, which is generally associated with age and weathering. Mainly, the resurfacing of the parking lot area will consist of grinding down the existing asphalt concrete pavement followed by placing new hot mix asphalt pavement. Additional treatment at specific areas of the parking lot includes removing the existing asphalt concrete pavement and underlying material, regrading and placing back new HMA pavement to allow for proper drainage.

Currently, access roads to the camping sites in the Lakeview Campground are unpaved with an approximate width of 24-feet. The improvements to the campground will include regrading of approximately one mile of dirt road and placing new hot mix asphalt pavement over an aggregate base to provide a smooth surface for vehicles.

Additional improvements include construction of concrete sidewalks, installation of detectable waning surfaces (truncated domes), parking bumpers, and placing new wood barriers. Drainage improvements include construction of a 4-feet wide concrete longitudinal gutter to convey water away from parking lot and the installation of shallow basin areas in the campground to mitigate water run-off as a result of paving the unpaved access road. Safety features include placing roadside signs, traffic stripes, thermoplastic crosswalks and pavement markings, and other associated work.

#### **Environmental Findings**

The proposed projects are exempt from CEQA under Section 15301 (c) – Existing Facilities exemption because the Rancho Jurupa Park Parking Lot Resurfacing and Roadway Paving Project does not create additional traffic lanes and involves negligible or no expansion of existing or former use of the existing roadway and associated facilities.

#### Impact on Citizens and Businesses

Rancho Jurupa Park is situated along the Santa Ana River. The park offers its visitors natural semi-rural setting of shady cottonwood trees, graceful meadows, and two lovely lakes. The purpose of this project is to rehabilitate a deteriorated parking lot area and to pave Lakeview Campground access roads to provide the public with a smooth paved roadway that will improve the safety and efficiency of vehicular traffic.

The work is scheduled to begin in December 2024. The work will be phased to keep the road open during construction as much as possible and will take approximately two months to complete.

The construction contract is estimated to cost approximately \$1,357,076. The improvements will be funded by the Riverside County Regional Park and Open-Space District with American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funds.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The Rancho Jurupa Regional Park Resurfacing project will include the removal and replacement of approximately 72,500 square feet (SF) of Asphalt Concrete (AC) in the northwest parking lot from the entrance of the park to the drainage crossings at the west end of the parking lot. Also, regrading and installation of new AC pavement on approximately one mile of existing dirt roads within the southwest RV campground area from the end of the existing paved road at the east entrance including all main roads to the west of the maintenance road will be performed.

#### Northwest Parking Lot

The parking lot area will include removal of approximately 72,500 SF of existing AC, recompacting of subgrade; installation of new AC pavement, additional subgrade excavation in specific areas to allow for proper drainage, American Disabilities Act (ADA) parking stall regrading, installation of approximately 1,550 linear feet (LF) of concrete gutter, restriping of parking lot including ADA compliant parking stalls and ADA signage, installation of concrete sidewalks, and replacement of wooden barrier ties along parking lot perimeter.

#### Southwest Recreational Vehicle (RV) Campground

Box 1090 Riverside, CA 92502-1090 FAX (951) 955-3198 **ENVIRONMENTAL ANALYSIS:** The project will extend the life of the pavement of the treated parking lot and improve camping areas by paving existing dirt roads, which is a benefit to the public. The project consists of maintenance and repair of an existing public areas.

The rehabilitation of a parking lot and paving existing dirt roads in the campground will be conducted by the County, who is a permittee as defined by the Western Riverside Multi-Species Habitat Conservation Plan (WRMSHCP). The project is subject to compliance within the WRMSHCP. The project is outside of designated MSHCP Criteria Cells; however, it is still subject to compliance with the WRCMSHCP. Under Section 7.1 Covered Activities Outside Criteria Area and PQP lands of the MSHCP, necessary operation and maintenance projects, are Covered Activities and are not subject to survey or mitigation requirements outside criteria area and Public/Quasi-Public Lands. These covered activities are subject to compliance with Best Management Practices as described in Appendix C of the WRMSHCP.

If tree and/or vegetation removal takes place during the migratory bird breeding season (February 1 – September 1), a preconstruction nesting survey will be conducted pursuant to the Migratory Bird Treaty Act.

The County has found that the above-described project is exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), based on the following:

Section 15301 (c) – Existing Facilities – The proposed project of pulverizing existing pavement in a parking lot and paving existing dirt roads in an existing campground with AC pavement are consistent with Section 15301(c) which exempts existing highways and streets, sidewalks, gutters, bicycle and pedestrian trails, and similar facilities, (this includes road grading for the purpose of public safety). Furthermore, the project does not create additional automobile lanes and involves minimal to no expansion of use of the exiting roadway and associated facilities.


