BACKGROUND:

Summary

This project proposes to refurbish and rehabilitate existing restrooms, expand available amenities like installation of a new pickle ball court, shade, seating, pool restoration, and landscaping. This project is slated to advertise for bids on September 2 and 9, 2024 and have bid opening Thursday, September 19, 2024. Due to the expansion of scope of amenity improvements since the last ARPA allocation on November 28, 2023, RivCoParks is requesting an additional allocation to cover the gap in the overall Project budget.

On March 11,2021, President Biden signed the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) of 2021 (H.R. 1319) into law. The \$1.9 trillion package is intended to combat the COVID-19 pandemic, including the public health and economic impacts. As part of the \$362 billion in federal fiscal recovery aid for state and local governments, \$65.1 billion is provided in direct aid to counties.

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Riverside County's share of the American Rescue Plan funding is \$479,874,599, of which the first installment of \$239,937,299 was received on May 10, 2021, and the second installment in the same amount was received on June 6, 2022. The funds must be obligated by December 31, 2024, and expended by December 31, 2026.

On October 4,2022, the Board of Supervisors approved the Second ARPA installment funding which allocated \$33 million per district to be obligated towards infrastructure, housing and homelessness, workforce development, neighborhood revitalization, business revitalization, childcare facilities, and non-profits.

Riverside County Regional Park and Open-Space District (RivcoParks) is recommending allocating an additional amount of \$6.5 million to further support the project from the Second ARPA allocation funding as follows:

 This project proposes to expand the available amenities at Lake Cahuilla Veteran's Regional Park, modernize existing restrooms, restore the non-functioning pool, expand available shade, install pickle ball courts, upgrade RV camping pedestals, and install an events stage.

Construction bid documents have been approved-as-to-form by County Counsel

Impact on Residents and Businesses

The Project will improve the quality of life for residents of Riverside County through the continued provision of clean, safe outdoor recreational opportunities.

Additional Fiscal Information

American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funds in the amount of \$5 million were previously allocated to this Lake Cahuilla Veteran's Regional Park on November 28, 2023, item 13.2 for the preparation of a Master Plan, refurbish and rehabilitate existing paving, and improve the existing structures and amenities. Due to the expansion of scope of amenity improvements since the last ARPA allocation on November 28, 2023, RivCoParks is requesting an additional allocation of \$6.5 million to cover the gap in the overall Project budget.

This request is funded by \$5.5 million from Fourth District's ARPA allocation and \$1 million from Countywide Department Response Contingency.

CEQA Considerations

The Riverside County Regional Park & Open-Space District staff conducted a review of the project and determined that the project qualifies for a Class 1 Categorical Exemption under Section 15301(c) of the CEQA Guidelines, Article 19 commencing with Section 15300. In accordance with Section 15301(c), Class 1 projects consist of the operation, repair, and maintenance of existing public facilities. Therefore, the project's proposed improvements at Lake Cahuilla Veteran's Regional Park are considered a Class 1 operation and maintenance project. Additionally, Section 15303 allows for the addition of small structures. The standalone outdoor stage would fall under this category.

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Staff therefore recommends that the Board of Supervisors (Board) find that the project is exempt under CEQA and direct the Clerk of the Board to file the Notice of Exemption with the County Clerk for posting within five (5) working days of this Board meeting with a posting period of not less than 30 days.

The successful Bidder and its subcontractors shall pay all workers on the Project not less than the general prevailing rate of per diem wages and the general prevailing rate for holiday and overtime work as determined by the Director of the Department of Industrial Relations, California, for the type of work performed and the locality in which the work is to be performed, per sections 1770 et seq. of the CA Labor Code. **Prevailing wage** rates are on file at the District and are available on request or at: www.dir.ca.gov/oprl/statistics and databases.html. Bidders and Bidders' subcontractors shall comply with the **DIR registration** and qualification requirements per sections 1725.5 and 1771.1 of the CA Labor Code.
