# BACKGROUND:

#### Summary

During the Fiscal Year 2024-25 Budget Hearing on June 10, 2024, the Executive Office presented a post-adoption budget action recommending \$28 million to support the Riverside University Health System – Medical Center (Medical Center) ongoing services in support of Riverside County residents who are incompetent, poor, indigent persons, and those incapacitated by age, disease, or accident, when such persons are not supported and relieved by their relatives or friends, by their own means, or by state hospitals or other state or private institutions pursuant to Welfare and Institutions Code section 17000.

These patients are amongst the most vulnerable residents, from seniors to infants. The RUHS Medical Center has been able to mitigate the vast majority of the indigent care impacts on the County, but the extraordinary growth of the County and this population, requires additional support to meet the legal obligations.

#### Impact on Residents and Businesses

This funding will allow RUHS to continue to provide services to some of the county's most vulnerable populations.

#### **Additional Fiscal Information**

Attachment A contains a budget adjustment in the total amount of \$28 million from the general fund for uncovered costs of mandated medical care for indigent individuals. The Executive Office and RUHS will continue to closely monitor the budget and anticipates no additional general fund will be required this fiscal year.
