## Summary

During the Fiscal Year 2024-25 Budget Hearing on June 10, 2024, the Executive Office presented a post-adoption budget action recommending \$18.6 million to support the Riverside University Health System – Medical Center (Medical Center) for acute medical care provided at the Medical Center to incarcerated adults and juveniles.

Providing this care at the Medical Center within a separated Detention Care Unit secured by the Riverside County Sheriff's Department allows the County to minimize the total cost of inmate care and enhances community safety by not disbursing inmates throughout community hospitals that lack the infrastructure of a separate secured unit.

## Impact on Residents and Businesses

This funding will allow RUHS to continue to provide required care to County inmates in a secure environment helping further enhance community safety.

### **Additional Fiscal Information**

Attachment A contains a budget adjustment in the total amount of \$18.6 million from the general fund for uncovered costs of mandated medical care for County inmates. The Executive Office and RUHS will continue to closely monitor the budget and anticipates no additional general fund will be required this fiscal year.
