

**BACKGROUND:**

**Summary**

The City of La Quinta has approved the First Amendment to the Agreement for Law Enforcement Services. As part of the amendment, the City of La Quinta has requested to convert a Traffic Officer to a Motor Officer. The conversion of a traffic officer to a motor officer does not create a significant cost impact to the city or RSO; therefore, no budget adjustment is needed. County Counsel has approved the First Amendment as to form.

FIRST AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT SERVICES BETWEEN THE CITY OF LA QUINTA AND THE COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE

IT IS MUTUALLY AGREED that the Agreement for Law Enforcement Services between the County of Riverside, a political subdivision of the State of California, on behalf of the Riverside County Sheriff's Office, and the City of La Quinta, a California Charter City, approved by the Board of Supervisors on July 11, 2023 in Minute Order 3.37 for services effective July 1, 2023 through June 30, 2025, is hereby amended in the following respects, and all other terms and conditions of the Agreement remain in full force and effect:

- 1. Attachment A of the Agreement is hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced with Attachment A-1, attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference.
2. Effective Date. This Amendment No. 1 shall become effective upon last signature of the parties.


