All bids must be received up to the hour of 2:00 p.m., Wednesday, October 2, 2024 at which time bids will be opened; and
- 4. Direct the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors to file the Notice of Exemption with the County Clerk and the State Clearinghouse for posting within five (5) working days.

# **BACKGROUND:**

# <u>Summary</u>

The Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) provides for the construction of the Pauba Road Widening Project between Via Del Monte and Calle Contento northerly in the Community of Rancho California of Riverside County.

The project proposes to reconstruct an approximately 1.1 miles segment of Pauba Road between Via Del Monte and Calle Contento. Pauba Road will be realigned both vertically and horizontally for better drivability and widened from the existing 20-feet wide road to a 28-feet wide road to accommodate two 12-foot travel lanes with 2-foot paved shoulders.

Roadway reconstruction will consist of removing the existing asphalt concrete and underlying material and placing new hot mix asphalt (HMA).

Additional improvements include construction of concrete driveways, asphalt concrete driveways, asphalt concrete dike, placement of safety edge and shoulder backing to protect the outside edge of pavement, construction of a graded trail for equestrian use, construction of concrete retaining walls, installation of fence and gates. Drainage improvements include construction of new culverts and replacement of existing culverts, installation of concrete headwalls at culverts inlets and outlets, installation of rock energy dissipators. Safety features include placing roadside signs, traffic stripes, thermoplastic crosswalks and pavement markings, and other associated work.

On November 17, 2020, the Riverside County Board of Supervisors directed the Executive Office to implement an Unincorporated Communities Initiative (UCI). The UCI is a focused, ongoing, and coordinated effort to improve the infrastructure and services provided to the residents of unincorporated communities, with emphasis on Disadvantaged Unincorporated Communities. Through March 31, 2021, the Executive Office team held 15 community meetings and conducted online surveys to better understand community needs for services, infrastructure, and infrastructure maintenance. Based on the foundational work completed by the UCI team, the Pauba Road Widening Project was selected as a recipient of \$898,291 of UCI funds from the third district per Minute Order dated May 23, 2023 (Agenda Item 3.6). funds were utilized in the design phase of the project and are not funding this construction contract.

The submitted plans and specifications have been approved as to form by County Counsel.

## **Environmental Findings**

The proposed project is exempt from CEQA under Section 15301(c) — Existing Facilities exemption because the Pauba Road Widening Project does not create additional traffic lanes and involves negligible or no expansion of existing or former use of the existing roadway and associated facilities. The project qualifies under this exemption since the project proposes to widen Pauba Road to standard lane widths and create shoulders for safety and equestrian use.

#### Impact on Citizens and Businesses

The proposed improvements will improve safety and traffic operations by eliminating the hazards associated with narrow roadway. The project will replace existing deteriorated pavement with new hot mix asphalt to provide the public with a smooth paved roadway that will improve the safety and efficiency of vehicular traffic.

The work is scheduled to begin in early 2025. The work will be phased to keep the road open during construction as much as possible and will take approximately four months to complete.

#### **Additional Fiscal Information**

The construction contract is estimated to cost approximately \$5,906,050. The County improvements will be funded with Measure A – Western Riverside County funds.

# NOTICE OF EXEMPTION

PROJECT TITLE: Pauba Road Widening Project

Work Order #ZC90063C, Task Code #Z1530

PROJECT SPONSOR: Riverside County Transportation Department

PROJECT LOCATION: Western Riverside County, Community of Rancho California

SUPERVISORIAL DISTRICT: Third

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The Riverside County Transportation Department (RCTD) proposes to widen Pauba Road between Via Del Monte Road northeast to Calle Contento, approximately 1.1 miles in length. The road will be widened from 22 feet to 28 feet. Two paved lanes will be 12 feet with a paved shoulder width of 2 feet, a 4-foot graded shoulder to the south, and an 8-foot graded shoulder on the north to accommodate equestrian use. The project will include the following:

- Reconstruct roadway and install hot mix asphalt over class 2 base.
- Retaining walls up to 8 feet high will be placed at various locations.
- Drainage improvements

Additional work includes grading shoulders, adjusting manholes to grade, adjusting water valve covers, new striping, pavement markings and raised pavement markers and other associated work as required. The project will require temporary construction easements for proposed improvements.

In accordance with Section 7.1 of the Western Riverside County MSHCP, necessary operation and maintenance along existing roadways are considered a covered activity outside cell criteria areas. The project will comply with MSHCP construction guidelines and BMP's. A pre-construction nesting bird survey will be required if construction takes place during the nesting bird season from February 1 to August 31.

The Riverside County Transportation Department Staff conducted a review of the above referenced project and has determined that the proposal qualifies for a Categorical Exemption per the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines.

The Riverside County Transportation Department has found that the above-described project is exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), based on the following:



# California Environmental Quality Act Guidelines:

Section 15301(c) – Existing Facilities – The project proposes to widen Pauba Road to standard lane widths and create shoulders for safety and equestrian use. This minor alteration to the existing public structure involves negligible or no expansion of use and is exempt from CEQA under Section 15301(c). The improvements are consistent with Section 15301(c) because the project is reconstruction of an existing road and associated facilities.


