

I am Mrs Montes, a resident and property owners in Thousand Palms, CA : 30700 Las Flores Way, 92276.



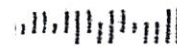

Dear County:

I am the owner and resident of 31285 Shadow Mountain Lane, Thousand Palms, CA. I live in unincorporated Riverside County, east of Thousand Palms, north of Ramon Road.

I protest the rate increase due to the unforeseen consequences that you need to consider. I understand the need to comply with state regulations, but if you raise trash collection rates, I foresee a problem you have not considered.

My house is on the edge of the desert near the transmission lines that cross the Coachella Valley. As trash collection rates are already high, I see trash dumped out here regularly. If rates increase, I can only fear that it will get worse, creating an environmental problem.

I walk my dogs along the power lines every day, and I have encountered a lot of refuse that should have gone to the collection facilities. I have seen construction trash, landscaping trash, household trash, and even the remnants of a pit bar-b-que that was apparently a goat. I have seen moldy hay, plastic, toys, sandbags, tires, and more.

I also have a home in Utah for which I pay \$13.00 a month so I can dump my

household trash in the bins next to the rodeo grounds. There is even a large bin for campers to dump their trash in on their way out of the canyon. The local dump is free. I have never seen a load of trash dumped anywhere there.

I hope you will consider what this rate increase will do to the environment in the desert.

5. Insufficient Public Education:

The success of SB 1383 relies heavily on public participation, yet there is a noticeable lack of public education on how to properly manage food waste. Before imposing fee increases, the County should invest in comprehensive outreach and education efforts to ensure residents are informed and equipped to comply with the new requirements. Empowering homeowners with knowledge can lead to better outcomes and reduced waste without the need for steep fee hikes.

6. Impact on Property Values:

Increasing waste collection fees could negatively affect property values in our community. Potential homebuyers may be deterred by higher living costs, which could slow down the real estate market and have long-term economic repercussions for the County.

In conclusion, while I fully support the environmental goals of SB 1383, I believe that the proposed fee hikes are not the right solution for Riverside County homeowners. 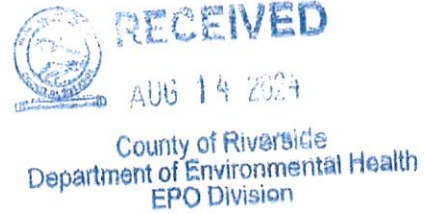

To who it may concern,

We write this letter in protest of the requested rate increased by CR&R.

If we believed that CR&R did what we already pay them for, then it would be understandable to increase the rates in this environment where everything costs more.

Our Tuesday trash, green waste and recycling pick up doesn't always happen on the scheduled date. To get them to come and pick up the next day, we have to spend 15-20 minutes of our time calling to have them come back and pick up the cans they missed.

We understand that since Covid, hiring and keeping employees has been difficult. During Covid we routinely received a recorded phone message saying that our pickup was delayed. We appreciated being notified and went with the flow knowing times were difficult.

Since then, we routinely have cans not picked up, and no longer receive recorded messages to alert us of a missed pickup. If we don't call on Wed to report our cans were not picked up, then we would have no pickup (per the customer service people we have spoken to).

We put our cans out on Monday night to be sure we are on the street by 6am Tuesday. We live on Grand Ave which is a very busy road. Our cans are frequently tampered with by morning, but they are out there if a truck comes by earlier than normal.

Once we didn't have our cans out and missed the pickup by an hour. We called and paid the \$12.02 to have the truck come back. When we go on vacation, we still pay for pickup with no credit available. When CR&R doesn't pick up on our scheduled day, we still pay for pickup with no credit available.

If we felt like CR&R was following through with a responsible service that we pay for, we would agree to a rate increase. However, at this time we protest this rate hike. CR&R has failed miserably in providing a consistent service to us, as good paying on time customers.



Subject: Formal Protest Against Proposed Solid Waste Collection Rate Increase

To: Department of Environmental Health

I am writing to formally protest the proposed increase in solid waste collection rates in Riverside County, as announced in the recent notice. As a concerned resident and taxpayer of Riverside County, I believe that this rate increase is unjustified and places an unnecessary financial burden on our community, particularly in the current economic climate.

The proposed rate hike does not appear to be adequately supported by a clear and transparent explanation of the need for such an increase. Additionally, it is concerning that residents have not been provided with sufficient data to understand the full impact of this rate change on household budgets.

The justification you lay out in the formal notice is absurd. Senate Bill 1383 is something that affects every homeowner in the state. Cities across California and in Riverside County are working hard to inform residents about what the bill really means and doing everything they can to educate the community. Meanwhile, the County has done ZERO outreach to people who live and work in the unincorporated areas. You claim that you will use extra funding to increase your communications with taxpayers but I will believe it when I see it. The waste haulers run the show and unincorporated County taxpayers get stuck with the bill. Burrtec believes that if they sponsor an event in the park, that is engaging with homeowners. They are a private company who does not want to spend money to market directly to homeowners. Riverside County would be wise to put the pressure on Burrtec to actually communicate, and not just take it for granted that we are all going to figure it out.


The proposed solid waste rate increase is insulting unless you can explain it to homeowners, who are also Burrtec customers, how their lives are going to change with the new SB 1383 rules.

I respectfully urge the Department of Environmental Health to reconsider this proposal and to conduct a more thorough analysis of the financial management of solid waste services. It is crucial that the Board explores alternative cost-saving measures and efficiencies within the current system before imposing additional costs on residents. Furthermore, I request that the Board provide more detailed information to the public regarding the necessity of this rate increase and future consequences.

Given these concerns, I strongly oppose the proposed rate increase and request that my protest be recorded in the official public record for the upcoming hearing on this matter.

Thank you for your attention to this issue. I look forward to your response and to the opportunity to engage in further discussions on how we can achieve more equitable and sustainable waste management practices in Riverside County.


We protest the proposed rate increase based on the fact that we cannot get a definite answer.

After numerous phone calls to CR&R and 1 to the Department of Environmental Health, it is still unclear whether we will receive a rate increase and what that increase might be. CR&R did not have us noted as having a pending increase – perhaps their lack of clarity is a timing situation in their computer system. Dept of Enviro Health said “everyone is going to receive an increase, and the \$37.13 is a *proposed* rate – the rate could be more, could be less”, that the word *proposed* simply meant the rate was an *estimate*. After receiving Supervisor Jeffries’ newsletter, we did check the Franchise Waste Hauler’s Agreements map for our rate, which also shows \$37.13.


We find this kind of ambiguity unacceptable. We realize rates everywhere have increased – fuel, labor, etc. However, living on a fixed income forces us to plan accordingly. And we’d be remiss not to mention that the quality of service has decreased, skipping us from time to time, along with often 1 truck picks up both the green waste and food waste in the same truck on the same stop. We believe this defeats the overall recycling goal, while it does reduce operating costs. A quandary for sure.

We have been paying the “proposed rate” of \$37.13/cart since July 2022. So, will someone please confirm with certainty what the increase will be, if any?

WHY RATE ADJUSTMENTS ARE NECESSARY

All jurisdictions in the State, including Riverside County, are subject to the most stringent solid waste legislation in California history. For County residents and businesses to remain in compliance with State Law, new services are necessary, none of which are funded by the State. Therefore, these services must be funded through the solid waste collection rates. This unfunded State mandate increases requirements for recyclables and organics to be diverted from disposal in landfills.

- State Senate Bill 1383 – mandates that California reduce organic waste by 75%, and increase edible food recovery by 20% by January 2025. As a result, green waste and food waste will no longer be able to be disposed of in the landfill. SB 1383 requires jurisdictions to allow food waste to be collected in residential green waste carts or cans, which is then subjected to mandatory processing that significantly increases the cost of handling that material.



To Whom it May Concern:

I reside at and own the residence located at 10215 Wrangler Way in Temescal Valley. In response to the Notice concerning Solid Waste Collection Rates, please be advised that **I PROTEST** the proposed rate increase for the following reasons:

1. THE RATE HAS ALREADY BEEN INCREASED

Since 2020 the rate for collection of a 3-cart system in my area has increased \$8.56 per month. This rate increase was, in part, due to the adding the green bin to the collection system. Now Waste Management and the County of Riverside seek to charge an additional \$3.16 on top of the already in place yearly inflation adjustments. WASTE MANAGEMENT AND THE COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE HAVE ALREADY INCREASED RATES IN RESPONSE TO SB 1383.

2. THERE IS NO AGE OR INCOME BASED RATE DISCOUNT

I might not have a problem with the rate increase if a discount was in place for low income customers or seniors. I DO NOT consider a \$1.00 discount for seniors to be a sufficient or adequate discount. Waste Management and the County of Riverside should have a program in place similar to Southern CA Edison's CARE program.

3. RATES SHOULD BE BASED ON USAGE

All other utilities base fees on usage. Why am I - a family of one generating very little waste - paying the same rate as a family of five generating five times the amount of waste? I put my carts out for collection, and therefore use the service, once a month - not once a week. And yet, I obligated to pay for weekly service. We should incentivize residents to generate less waste by rates based on usage.

Section 8(D) of Riverside County Ordinance No. 745 purports to allow collection every two weeks instead of weekly upon request of a waiver. However, it is not clear from the ordinance whether such a waiver would include a fee reduction as well.

4. COMPULSORY SERVICE

Under Riverside County Ordinance No. 745, the collection service is compulsory and most customers would be unable to feasibly opt out of the service. Therefore, we are FORCED to pay the rate set. And if we refuse to pay or cannot pay, instead of going through normal channels of recouping nonpayment, the delinquent charges are added to our property tax bills, possibly resulting in foreclosure of our property. This is not a just means of providing service.

In conclusion, it is clear that the County and WM's business model of collection service is severely flawed. Before any new rate increase goes into effect discounts for low income residents should be offered and alternative rates based on actual use of the collection service should be implemented.



We are "snowbirds" and reside at 35920 Crescent Street in Palm Desert, Ca. 92211. This is a senior community in Sun City.

We PROTEST this latest proposed green and organic waste proposition! We spend approximately five month a year at our residence. As seniors who eat out many times during the week we produce little, if any, organic waste. Our gardener removes ALL green waste from the premises. 

Therefore, we are retired and have no income. My husband and I strongly request that we will be exempted from pay this \$36.28 fee of along with the new SB1383-compliant service.



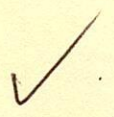
