BACKGROUND:

Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

- 1. **Smiles for Seniors Foundation** \$3,000- The funds will be used to support the Low-Income Senior Emergency Assistance program, a program that provides emergency food and utility assistance, minor home and auto repairs, life-saving medications, and medical equipment to low-income seniors.
- 2. **SAFE Family Justice Center-**\$2,500- This allocation will support Riverside County PAL's 20th Anniversary Event, an event that recognizes both mentees and law enforcement officers who have demonstrated exceptional leadership.
- 3. Fair Housing Council of Riverside County, INC.-\$2,000- The funding will support the 2025 Housing Conference, an event that brings together the community, non-profits, government officials, lenders, builders, developers, and policymakers, housing providers, realtors, and community leaders to discuss the future of housing in the Inland Empire.
- 4. **Murrieta Chamber of Commerce** \$2,000- The funds will be used to support the 64th Annual Awareness celebration, an event that recognizes local businesses and individuals that make a difference in the community.
- 5. **Reaching New Heights Foundation**-\$5,000- This allocation will support the Veterans Standdown Resource Event, an event that focuses on supporting the homeless and at-risk veteran population in the county.
