BACKGROUND: Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

1. **Rustic Lane Elementary School- \$3,000** will be used for the Community Schools Transformative Youth Theatre Project, allowing students from K-12 to participate in a high quality program with access to premium materials and supplies.
2. **Family Service Association - \$5,000** will be used to support the “HOPE for the Holidays” program that provides foster children and youth with a toy, a warm blanket, essential toiletries, and a duffel bag to tote their belongings with integrity in a difficult period of life.
3. **Student of the Month Program- \$550** funding will be used to support the Perris Valley and Menifee Chamber of Commerce with the local high school recognition program by providing scholarships and awards for First District students.
4. **Soroptimist International of Riverside, LLC - \$3,000** will be used to support the “Live Your Dream – Dream It Be It” mentor conference for middle school aged girls in the AVID program who typically are in families without college graduates in the home.
