BACKGROUND: Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

1. The donation to California Inland Empire Council, Boy Scouts of America (\$2,500.00) will support the Scout Me in with STEAM! Initiative to provide a variety of STEAM subjects such as Aviation, Art, Digital Technology, and Graphic Design to elementary, middle, and high school youth.
2. The donation to Jurupa Valley Citizens Patrol (\$4,000.00) will be used to purchase one EcoFlow Battery Operated Portable Power Station and an extra battery for the power station for the Jurupa Valley Station Volunteer Program to allow the powering of LED Flood Lights that the volunteers utilize in all aspects of their service to the community.
3. The donation to the Corona Symphony Orchestra (\$4,000.00) will be used to provide musical equipment for the Youth Conservatory program which offers a complete curriculum for youth ages 6-18 years old, including small group lessons, music theory, and a large performance ensemble.
