## **BACKGROUND:**

The Agricultural Commissioner's Office Weights and Measures division is responsible for protecting both consumers and businesses that conduct business with Riverside County. This is done by ensuring that commercial weighing and measuring devices are accurate and reliable.

The office is entrusted with the mission of fostering confidence and equity in the marketplace through education and the fair and uniform enforcement of laws, regulation, and ordinances enacted by the people of the State of California and the County of Riverside.

On June 8, 2006, pursuant to the authority granted in California Business and Professions Code §12210, the Board of Supervisors adopted Ordinance No. 620 entitled "An Ordinance of the County of Riverside Amending Ordinance No. 620 Providing for Imposition of Charges for Inspection and Testing of Certain Commercial and Non-Commercial Weighing and Measuring Instruments," which is known as the "Inspection and Testing of Non-Commercial Weighing and Measuring Instruments Ordinance."

Ordinance No. 620 established fees for the testing of non-commercial weighing and measuring instruments. Actual time expended is comprised of an hourly rate and mileage accrued of the inspector at the time services are rendered multiplied by the hours or fraction of hours expended in ¼ hour increments. Since Ordinance No. 620 has been adopted, the Agricultural Commissioner's Office, based on departmental cost analysis, deems it necessary to amend the hourly rate for services requested to recuperate a portion of the department overhead for cost recovery. The proposed rates have been made based on comparative analysis of hourly rates assessed by neighboring counties for similar performed work, departmental revenue, expenditures, and labor costs.

It is recommended that the Board of Supervisors adopt Ordinance No. 620.

# AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 620 PROVIDING FOR IMPOSITION OF CHARGES FOR INSPECTION AND TESTING OF CERTAIN COMMERCIAL AND NON-COMMERCIAL WEIGHING AND MEASURING INSTRUMENTS

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside ordains as follows:

Section 1. Subsection A. of Section 5. of Ordinance No 620 is amended to read as

## follows:

A: The fees for the inspection and testing of non-commercial weighing and measuring devices shall be paid in accordance with the following schedule. All charges to be on a portal-to-portal basis plus mileage charges, as indicated. Standby time will be computed at the same hourly rate as indicated for the specified device, at 15-minute intervals (or 0.25-hours), and at a minimum inspection charge of 30-minutes (or 0.5-hours):

# Section 2. Subsection G. is added to Section 5. of Ordinance No. 620 as follows:

G. Devices must be picked up by the responsible party within thirty (30) days of notification that inspection has been completed. An additional storage charge of \$50 per day will be incurred for devices that are not picked up within thirty (30) days. Devices that are not picked up after sixty (60) days of notification of completed inspection work will be discarded by the County Agricultural Department.

# Section 3. Section 6. of Ordinance No. 620 is amended to read as follows:

A. The fees for the inspection and testing of commercial weighing and measuring devices shall be

ORDINANCE NO. 620 (AS AMENDED THROUGH 620.5)

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 620 PROVIDING FOR IMPOSITION OF CHARGES FOR INSPECTION AND

TESTING OF CERTAIN COMMERCIAL AND NON-COMMERCIAL WEIGHING AND MEASURING INSTRUMENTS

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside, Ordains as Follows:

**SECTION 1. TITLE.** This ordinance shall be known as the "Inspection and Testing of Non-Commercial Weighing and Measuring Instruments Ordinance."

#### SECTION 2. PURPOSE AND AUTHORITY. The purpose of the ordinance is to esta-

blish a schedule of fees for inspecting and testing certain commercial and non-commercial weighing and measuring instruments when the testing can legally be performed by a registered repairman. Ordinance No. 599 provides for owners of commercial weighing and measuring instruments to pay registration fees to partially defray the costs of inspecting and testing the instruments. The Business and Professions Code mandates the inspection and testing of these instruments. However, the County has no provision to recover costs for inspecting and testing instruments that are not mandated by the Business and Professions Code, such as non-commercial devices. The authority for this ordinance is Division 5, Chapter 2, Article 2 (beginning with Section 12210) of the California Business and Professions Code. The ordinance is adopted pursuant to Title 3, Division 2, Part 2, Chapter 1, Article 7 (beginning with Section 25120) of the Government Code.

**SECTION 3. DEFINITIONS.** Unless otherwise specifically provided or required by the context, certain terms or expressions used herein have meanings as set forth below:

**A.** "Weighing and measuring instruments" shall mean "weighing instruments" or "measuring instruments" as each are respectively defined by Section 12500 of the California Business and Professions Code. **B.** "Commercial purposes" shall have the meaning assigned to it by Section 12500 of the California Business and Professions Code.

C. "Weights and Measures Division" means the Weights and Measures Division of the Department of Agriculture of the County of Riverside. D. "Sealer" means the Sealer of Weights and Measures of the Department of Agriculture and his duly authorized agents.

## SECTION 4. FEES. All fees shall be based on the recommended schedule of fees publis-

hed by the Division of Measurement Standards, State Department of Food and Agriculture, as revised from time to time. All fees collected shall be credited to the General Fund of the County and used only for the administration and enforcement of laws pertaining to the Weights and Measures Division.

### SECTION 5. FEES FOR NON-COMMERCIAL DEVICES.

**A.** The fees for the inspection and testing of non-commercial weighing and measuring devices shall be paid in accordance with the following schedule. All charges to be on a portal-to-portal basis plus mileage charges, as indicated. Standby time will be computed at the same hourly rate as indicated for the specified device, at 15-minute intervals (or 0.25-hours), and at a minimum inspection charge of 30-minutes (or 0.5-hours): Type of Device Price Per Hour

Small Capacity Scales, Retail \$150.00\* Gasoline Dispensers, Liquified Petroleum Gas, other Compressed Natural Gas Meters & All Other Devices

\$3.75 per mile for vehicles exceeding 40,000 lbs. GVW, plus \$200.00 per hour.

**B.** An additional fee of equal amount shall be collected when devices are tested after 5:00 p.m. on weekdays, or on Saturdays, Sundays and Holidays.

C. No devices will be tested between the hours of 8:00 p.m. and 8:00 a.m.

D. Whenever a device cannot be sealed after the first test, and if additional tests are

required, a fee of like amount shall be collected for each additional test. **E.** Whenever specialized equipment is rented to perform a requested test, the cost of the

rented equipment will be prorated to the requesting agency. F. All requests for inspection will be made in writing.

G. Devices must be picked up by the responsible party within thirty (30) days of notificat-

ion that inspection has been completed. An additional storage charge of \$50 per day will be incurred for devices that are not picked up within thirty (30) days. Devices that are not picked up after sixty (60) days of notification of completed inspection work will be discarded by the County Agricultural Department. **SECTION 6. FEES FOR COMMERCIAL DEVICES WHEN REQUESTED BY OWNER/USER.A.** The fees for the inspection and testing of commercial weighing and measuring devices

shall be paid in accordance with the following schedule. All charges to be on a portal-to-portal basis plus mileage charges, as indicated. Standby time will be computed at the same hourly rate as indicated for the specified device, at 15-minute intervals (or 0.25-hours), and at a minimum inspection charge of 30-minutes (or 0.5-hours): Type of Device Price Per Hour Small Capacity Scales, Retail \$150.00\*

#### SECTION 7. PAYMENT OF FEES AND PENALTIES.

Fees for the inspection and testing of weighing and measuring devices shall be due and payable upon completion of the services. Fees not paid upon completion of the services shall be subject to a surcharge of 10% of the total fees together with a charge for costs of collection and attorney fees, if any. **SECTION 8:** This ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days after adoption.
