# Summary 8 1

On June 27, 2023, the Executive Office adopted the Fiscal Year 2023/24 Recommended Budget that included an increase of \$250,000 to the Executive Office for services in the Highgrove with the D1 Public Benefit Fund, originally generated by cannabis retail facilities within the community.

This project involves improvements to the Norton Younglove Community Center and Other County Facilities in Highgrove. The scope includes both interior and exterior painting of the community center, exterior painting of the Fire Station, replacing of the community center flooring, upgrading the kitchen, installing new HVAC units, and other enhancements to improve the facility.
