BACKGROUND:

Summary

By Minute Order dated July 2, 2024 (Agenda Item 3.21), the County of Riverside Board of Supervisors authorized the Clerk of the Board to advertise for the construction of the Carver Tract Sidewalk Safety Improvement Project Phase 2 in the Community of Carver Tract bordering the City of Indio and City of Coachella, in the unincorporated area of the County of Riverside.

The project will include the construction of various segments of concrete sidewalk, for a combined length of approximately 7,100-feet, along the following six streets of the Carver Tract community:

- Lingayen Avenue
- Corregidor Avenue
- Leyte Avenue
- Manila Avenue
- Luzon Street
- Bataan Street

The project will include roadway resurfacing improvements that consist of removing the existing asphalt concrete pavement and underlying material and placing back new Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA) pavement.

Additional improvements include construction of concrete curb and gutter, cross gutters and spandrels, curb ramps, and driveways. Drainage improvements include construction of catch basins, construction of dry well catch basins, gutter depressions, and installation of trash capture devices in various catch basins. Safety features include placing of roadside signs, retroreflective pavement markers, and thermoplastic crosswalks and pavement markings.

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The proposed improvements will provide a fully American with Disabilities Act (ADA) accessible all-weather pathway for pedestrians.

On March 11, 2021, President Biden signed the \$1.9 trillion American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) of 2021 into law. To accelerate recovery from the economic and health impacts of the COVID-19 pandemic, the County of Riverside was provided approximately \$480 million. The Executive Office in conjunction with the Board Supervisors developed a plan to disburse these funds based on the principles of providing recovery funding to those sectors of our economy and society that are struggling most to recover from the pandemic; have a constituent and community based focus; provide a vehicle for transformational investment in our County's recovery from COVID-19; provide for countywide equity; and focus on one time investments, rather than funding ongoing operational costs. As a result of these principles, the Carver Tract Sidewalk Safety Improvement Project Phase 2 was selected as a recipient of \$3,500,000 of ARPA funds from District 4 per Minute Order dated July 11, 2023 (Agenda Item 3.44).

During the advertisement period, one addendum was issued to all registered plan holders as a supplement to the plans and specifications. Bidders were required to acknowledge and take into account the issued addendum on their contractor's Bid in order to be considered for award.

The addendum was issued to clarify and modify the approved contract documents. The addendum is attached and designated as Addendum No. 1.

The Contract includes the following schedules of work:

Base Bid Schedule:	Carver Tract Sidewalks Project and associated work
Alternate Bid Schedule:	Facilities Adjustments for Valley Sanitary District

Valley Sanitary District (VSD) has accepted the bid prices proposed by Granite Construction Company for Alternative Bid Schedule 1, which include adjustments of ten (10) sewer manholes to grade, and the cost for the work will be reimbursed by VSD through a reimbursement letter Agreement that will be executed by the Director of Transportation. The Director of Transportation has the authority to sign reimbursement Agreements up to \$100,000 per Minute Order dated November 19, 2019 (Agenda Item 3.25).

Project No. D0-0071

Impact on Residents and Businesses

The project will improve pedestrian safety and provide an ADA compliant path. In addition to the residents along the project limits, there are several community facilities providing goods and services to local residents that are within walking distance of the project and will be served by the project improvements including: Martin Van Buren Elementary School, New Seasons Church, Coachella Valley Rescue Mission, Coachella Valley Wild Bird Center, Riverside County Office of Education, Rancho Las Flores Park, and the United Families/Fred Young Farm Labor Center.

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The work is scheduled to begin in late fall 2024. The work will be phased to keep the roads open during construction as much as possible and will take approximately five and a half months to complete.

SUPPLEMENTAL:

Additional Fiscal Information

Construction is expected to be completed in Fiscal Year 2024/2025 and will be funded with Gas Tax/HUTA, SB 821 (Local Transportation Fund), American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA), and Valley Sanitary District funds.

There are no General Funds used in this project.

Contract History and Price Reasonableness

A total of two bids were received on Wednesday July 31, 2024 ranging from \$3,922,922 to \$4,518,000. The basis for the selection of a contractor is the lowest responsive and responsible bid. The lowest responsive and responsible bid was submitted by Granite Construction Company in the amount of \$3,922,922 which is \$194,678 (4.7%) below the engineer's cost estimate.

The Transportation Department recommends the award of the contract to Granite Construction Company in the amount of \$3,922,922.

Contract

THIS CONTRACT is entered into at Riverside, California as of the date set forth below is between County of Riverside hereafter called "County" and **Granite Construction Company**, hereafter called "Contractor".

WITNESSETH

Recitals:

1. Contractor has submitted to County his Contractor's Proposal for the construction of County Project, **Carver Tract Sidewalk Safety Improvement Project Phase 2, Lingayen Avenue, Corregidor Avenue, Leyte Avenue, Manila Avenue, Luzon Street, and Bataan Street, Community of Carver Tract, Project No. D0-0071**, in strict accordance with the Contract Documents identified below and County has accepted said Proposal.
2. Contractor states that he has reexamined his Contractor's Proposal and found it to be correct, has ascertained that his subcontractors are properly licensed and possess the requisite skill and forces, has reexamined the site and Contract Documents and is of the opinion that he can presently do the work in accordance with the Contract Documents for the money set forth in his Proposal to be paid as provided in the Contract Documents.

Agreement:

It is agreed by the parties as follows:

1. Contract Documents

The entire Contract consists of the following: (a) The Construction Contract, (b) The Notice to Bidders, (c) The Instruction to Bidders, (d) The Bid, (e) The Bid Bond, (f) The Payment Bond, (g) The Performance Bond, (h) The General Conditions, (i) The Special Provisions, (j) The Standard Specifications of the State of California Department of Transportation edition of **2018** as modified in other portions of the Contract Documents and as amended by the State of California Department of Transportation, (k) The Standard Plans of the Department of Transportation identified on the plans or in the Special Provisions, (l) The Plans, (m) Addenda **(One)**, (n) The Determination of Prevailing Wage Rates for Public Works, (o) Any Change Orders issued, and (p) Any additional or supplemental specifications, notice, instructions and drawings issued in accordance with the provisions of the Contract Documents. All of said Documents presently in existence are by this reference incorporated herein with like effect as if here set forth in full and upon the proper issuance of other documents they shall likewise be deemed incorporated. The Bid Bond is exonerated upon execution of this Contract and the Payment Bond and Performance Bond.

2. The Work

Contractor shall do all tasks necessary to construct the work generally described in Recital No. 1 in accordance with the Contract Documents.

3. Prosecution, Progress and Liquidated Damages

Attention is directed to the provisions in Section 8-1.04,"Start of Job Site Activities", Section 8-1.05, "Time", and in Section 8-1.10 "Liquidated Damages" of the Standard Specifications and these Special Provisions.

Standard Specification Section 8-1.04B, "Standard Start" is modified to read as follows:

The Contractor shall begin work within fifteen (15) calendar days, or as revised in the Special Provisions, of the date stated within the written "Notice to Proceed".

The Contractor shall notify the Engineer, in writing, of the Contractor's intent to begin work at least 72 hours before work is begun. If the project has more than one (1) location of work, Contractor shall submit a separate notice for each location. The notice shall be delivered to the Transportation Department's Construction Engineer and shall specify the date the Contractor intends to start at said location.

Should the Contractor begin work in advance of receiving a written "Notice to Proceed", any work performed by the Contractor in advance of the date stated in the "Notice to Proceed" shall be considered as having been done by the Contractor at his own risk and as a volunteer and subject to the following:

- A. The Contractor shall, on commencing operations, take all precautions required for public safety and shall observe all the provisions in the Specifications and the Special Provisions.
- B. All work done according to the Contract, prior to the issuance of the "Notice to Proceed", will be considered authorized work and will be paid for as provided in the contract.
- C. The Contractor shall not be entitled to any additional compensation or an extension of time for any delay, hindrance or interference caused by or attributable to commencement of work prior to the issuance of the "Notice to Proceed".

4. Compensation

Contractor shall be paid in the manner set forth in the Contract Documents the amount of his Proposal as accepted by County, the above rates, subject to additions and deductions as provided in the Contract Documents. Said Proposal is on file in the Office of the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors of County.

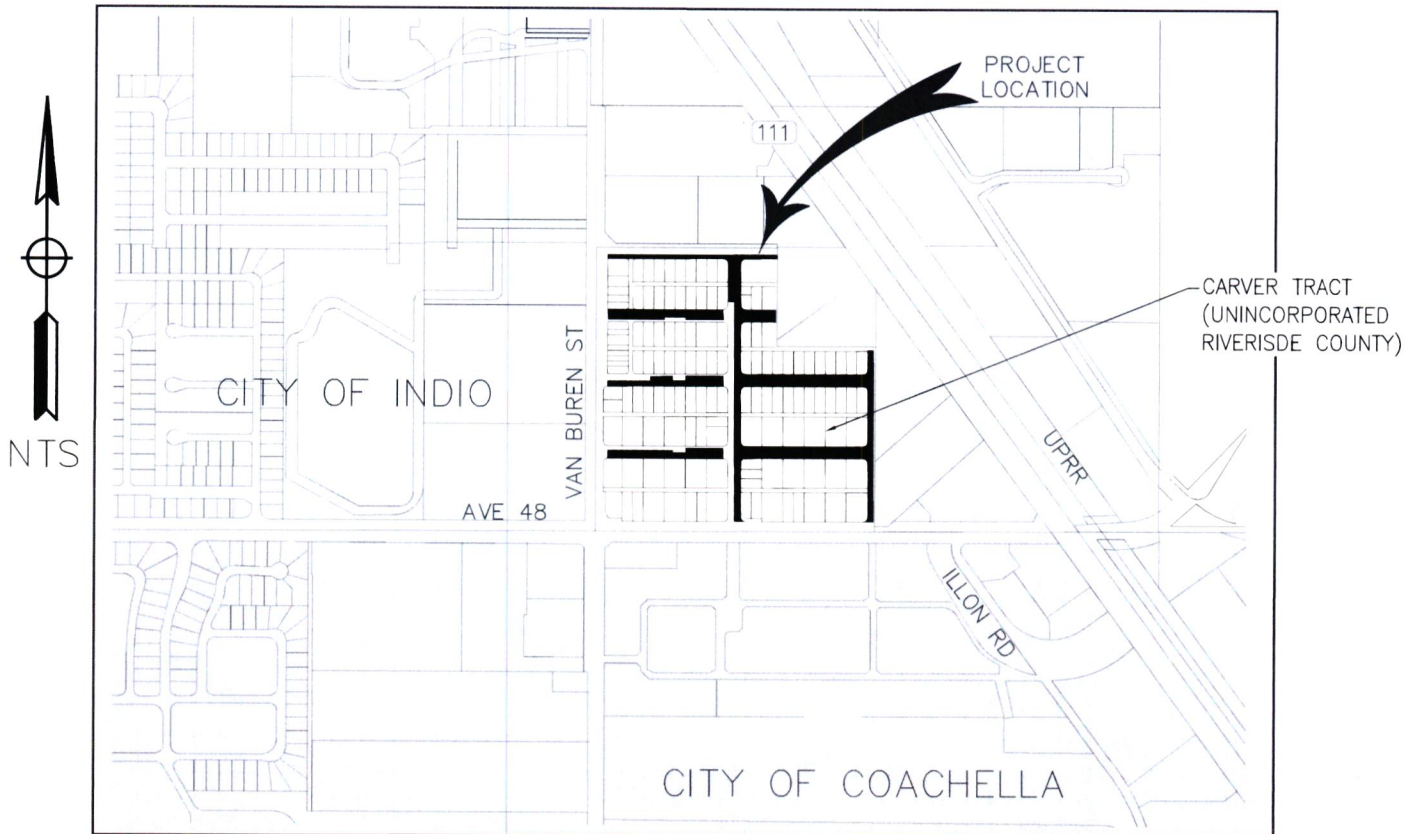
