

BACKGROUND: Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

1. ABC Recovery Center’s mission is to provide an environment for those with substance-use disorders to achieve lifelong sobriety and re-enter the community as healthy and responsible individuals. The Center has been operating over 62 years, maintaining a 12-acre campus and treating over 1000 participants per year.

ABC Recovery Center was awarded a grant from the State of California for the Substance-Use and Mental Health Expansion Project. This expansion includes the buildout of a six-acre parcel, building men’s dorm with 80 beds and a women’s dorm with 40 beds to expand their substance use disorder services. In addition, the Center must upgrade their existing power poles and run the service underground. The costs of the power infrastructure fall outside of the BHCIP expansion project, and it is approximately \$500,000.

CID funds will be used for offsite mitigation costs to enhance the power infrastructure.
