BACKGROUND: Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

1. The donation to the Eastvale Chamber of Commerce (\$350.00) will support local law enforcement such as fire and police departments and allow the Chamber to continue in its promotion of growth in the City of Eastvale.
2. The donation to Community Outreach Ministry (\$2,000.00) will support the 24th Annual Christmas Event to help children of incarcerated parents break the cycle of poverty, illiteracy, drugs, and violence through outreach, mentoring, food, and clothing in Lake Elsinore, Lakeland Village, and Canyon Lake.
3. The donation to Shoes that Fit (\$2,000.00) will be used to purchase 134 new pairs of athletic shoes for children at a local middle school in Jurupa Valley who face financial hardship.
4. The donation to the Childhood Drowning Prevention Foundation (\$2,000.00) will support the Drowning Prevention Heroes Charity Event to prevent childhood drowning and expand outreach within the community.
5. The donation to the Chabad Center of Riverside (\$4,000.00) will support the annual community-wide Chanukah Festival to embrace cultural diversity and understanding within our region.
